Categories, Fees & Quota

The years of birth admitted for Ski Cross are 2001-2005.

A maximum of 6 women and men may start per event.

The Fee is CHF 40.- per event day per athlete including Lift Ticket.

The fee for Team officials is as well CHF 40.- per event day and per person. We open the quota for officials.
