REGISTRATION:

Online Entry for registration is now available through usasa.org and will close on Friday, January 28, 2022 at midnight. (No on site registration or application is available)

Current USASA and FIS memberships are required for all competitors who wish to enter the FUTURES TOUR competitions.

ALL athletes 18 years and older, adult compliances (SafeSport and Background Screen) must be completed for these memberships prior to registration for the event.



Registration Requirements

Registration will only be available online at www.usasa.org through the regional series hosting the Future Tour competition (Big Mountain West).

Cost of Registration - \$125.00 per event <https://members.usasa.org/regionals?series=R54>

Competitors are required to have current USASA, US Ski & Snowboard, and FIS membership in order to register. **An active membership for each USASA, US Ski & Snowboard, and FIS** is required for registration. The minimum age for entry into the contest is 13. All adult members (18 and over) must clear a background screen and pass Safe Sport education protocols **prior to registering** for the event.

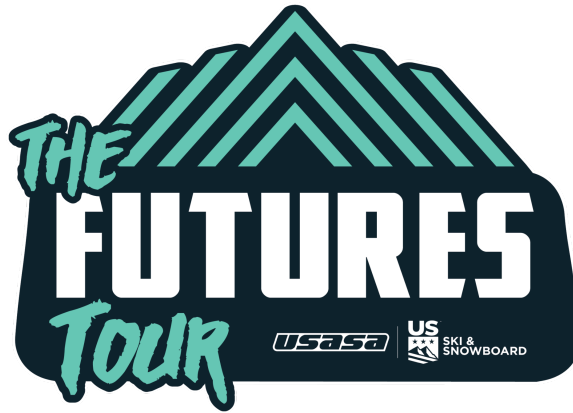
Each individual competition discipline must be registered for online separately.

Bib included in registration. Bib Distribution location and times to be posted on TeamApp. <https://bigmtnwest.teamapp.com>

Coaches Registration - All coaches are asked to register as Non-Competitors under each event on usasa.org for contact tracing purposes.

Park City Mountain Competition Liability Waiver - will be posted on Team App 1/26/22

***The Mountain Liability Waiver for Vail Resorts must be completed for each athlete, coach, official, staff and volunteer. The waiver needs to be completed on-line and on the Big Mtn West Team App under documents / 1-26-2022.**



Vail Resorts/PC Mountain waivers will NOT be collected on site. This waiver is an event waiver and is required regardless if already an Epic passholder.

Lift Tickets: For practice/competition day/coaches tickets and rate for competitors who do not have an epic pass.

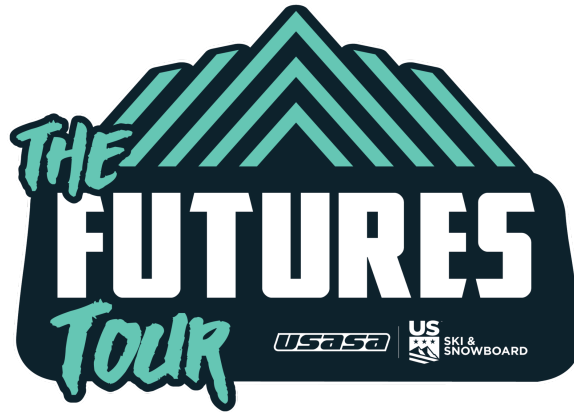
Practice/Training Day Lift Tickets / January 31, 2022

Training Day Tickets will be available on Monday, January 31, 2022 for \$75.00.

Pre-registered athletes will be on a list at the PAYDAY ticket window and can purchase training day tickets.

Competitor lift tickets can be purchased for \$40 per day at the PAYDAY Ticket Window Ticket Window. The ticket office will have the names of all athletes registered in the competition and you will be able to purchase a multi day lift ticket to get you through the whole competition. Lift tickets for registered coaches will be distributed daily at the lift by an event volunteer.

For those who hold an Epic Pass/Check your team privileges. Make a reservation for these competitions if you pass requires you to do so.

 - One heat of Freeski Women and a Finals
 - One heat of Snowboard Women and a Finals
 - Freeski Men Finals

- February 3 - 9:00-11:00 - Eagle Superpipe - Freeski & Snowboard Halfpipe Competition
 - One Heat Snowboard Men Qualification and Finals
 - One Heat Freeski Men Qualification and Finals
 - One heat of Women Freeski and Snowboard together 2 runs no Finals

- February 4 - 9:00-4:00 - Pick n Shovel - Snowboard Men Slopestyle Competition
 - Two Heats of Men and a Finals

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Safety Protocols:

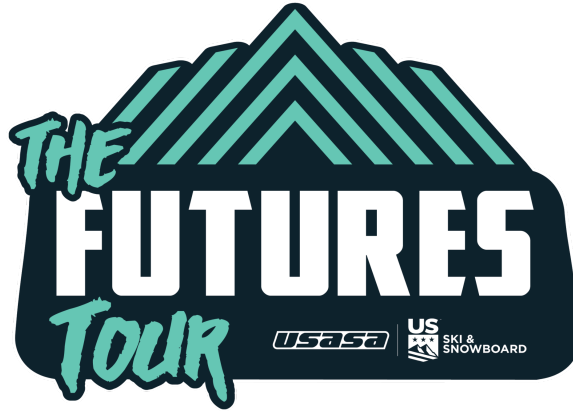
We will follow all USASA [Protocols](#) and US Ski and Snowboard [Protocols](#) as this competition is sanctioned by both as well as FIS

- Masks will be required at all times when lined up and not actively skiing/riding
- All event info will be shared via Team App
- COVID Coordinator responsibilities will be shared with PCSS Executive Director Christie Hind and Dr. Eileen Gallagher pediatrician.

Points:

- Athletes will receive USASA Regional and National Ranking points in your age group and FIS points. The competitions will be scored on an open range and then age group. The FIS result will not reflect age groups. All results will also be scored on the WSPL.
- FIS rules will be followed and USASA rules respected. Finals formats will be determined at the TC meeting prior to the competition.
