- 4. All athletes must have a FC Air 4B certified coach present. Athlete Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury

IMPORTANT COVID INFORMATIONS

Due to COVID, no spectators are allowed on site. Centre d'Excellence acrobatique Val Saint-Come will not be available for any athletes, parents, coaches as per Public Health rules. Only volunteers and officials will be allowed inside depending on their responsibilities.

Single mogul format (MO) – Alex-Bilodeau Run

Qualifications: single run

Final: Single run. Top 16 athletes of each gender taken from Qualifications Super Final: Single run. Top 6 athletes of each gender taken from Final

Dual Moguls Format (DM) - Alex-Bilodeau Run

Final: Dual format seeded from highest rank on either latest available FIS points ranking or current year NORAM cup ranking before 1st day of training day.

Licences

Canadian Athletes are required to have a Can Free 4 FIS License. International Athletes must have an active FIS license.

Competition office – The competition office will be located in Le Centre d'Excellence Acrobatique Val Saint-Côme. ALL Participants must check in and register on-site at the main desk to confirm participation in the event and to pick up competition bibs.

Bibs – \$20.00 CAD cash bib deposit is required at registration. Bibs must be returned at the end of course or to the race office, in good condition. If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be an additional \$20 CAD deposit. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, if you need to replace your bib please ensure the on-site registration staffs updates your entry information. Bibs **must** be worn properly for all on-site training, for the competitions and for awards ceremonies.

<u>Lift Tickets</u> – Athletes must purchase tickets from the resort ticket booth. Athletes must show/wear bib when purchasing tickets for discount. MC/Visa accepted for lift ticket purchase. RFID technology now used in Val Saint-Come so same ticket will be used for whole event. In case of lost ticket, a new one will have to be purchased.

Athletes: 65.76\$ CAD (plus taxes) for students (proof required) and 88.00\$ CAD for adults for the 4 days of the event

Coaches and officials: Free and available at race office

Team Captain Meeting – Team Captain meeting will be held at Le Centre d'Excellence Acrobatique Val Saint-Côme, from Thursday February 3rd at 2:30 pm for Moguls events. Refer to detailed schedule.
