The event is sanctioned by FIS and Freestyle Canada and part of the Canada Cup Series. It is valued in the Canada Cup Rankings.

Rules

1. The event is sanctioned by FIS and FC, and is organized by Le Centre d'Excellence Acrobatique Val Saint-Côme in collaboration with La Station Touristique Val Saint-Côme.
2. Rules are based on a combination of FIS Rules and Regulations and Freestyle Canada Canada Cup Competition Guidelines

3. The Competition is comprised of 2 Moguls events (Single and Dual event)
4. **All athletes must have a FC Air 4B certified coach present.
Athlete Qualification is required for all inverted maneuvers with Aerial Passports readily available to present to the Event Jury**

Registration

250\$/participant for Moguls events (both MO and DM) **without** lift tickets (plus fees).

350\$/participant for Moguls events (both MO and DM) **with** lift tickets (plus fees).

Participants must register and make payments online using the snowreg registration system. Registration closes March 18th 2022 at 5 PM ET.

Field Size

Moguls : Maximum athletes to register is 90 + 10 spots for Foreign athletes (45 + 5 spots for Men & 45 +5 spots for women). Any unused spots will move to the other gender.

10 spots for Foreign Athletes

As a FIS event, National Championships must offer spots for Foreign athletes. If those spots are unused, they can move to Canadian allocation and may be used by eligible athletes.

- 5 women/5 men – Any unused spots will move to the other gender
- If more than 10 Foreign athletes register, priority will be given to athletes with highest FIS points.

Eligibility

- As a FIS Event, FIS age required : 14 as of January 1st in the year of the event
 - **Age Categories:** There are no age categories for this event.
- National team athletes automatically earn a spot
- Canadian athletes who have earned a NORAM spot in the current season earn a spot
- Remaining spots will be allocated based on :
 - Canada Cup Rankings following the most recent Canadian Series event
 - Club athletes who made a top 20 at a Canadian Series event (singles or duals) in the current season
 - The current Canada Cup Rankings will be used to rank the eligible club athletes
 - Injury clause could be in effect under the guidance of the individual PSO
- Foreign athletes must be approved by their country and Freestyle Canada

Single mogul format (MO) – Alex-Bilodeau Run

Qualifications: single run

Final: 40% of the field for each gender, 1 run

Dual Moguls Format (DM) – Alex-Bilodeau Run

Qualifications: single run

Final: Dual format for up to 24 athletes of each gender seeded from qualifications. Top 8 athletes of each gender have a “by pass”.

Licences

Canadian Athletes are required to have a **Can Free 4 FIS License**.
International Athletes must have an active FIS license.

Competition office – The competition office will be located in Le Centre d'Excellence Acrobatique Val Saint-Côme. **ALL Participants must check in** and register on-site at the main desk to confirm participation in the event and to pick up competition bibs.

Bibs – \$20.00 cash bib deposit is required. Bibs must be returned at the end of course or to the race office, in good condition. If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be an additional \$20 deposit. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, if you need to replace your bib please ensure the on-site registration staffs updates your entry information. Bibs **must** be worn properly for all on-site training, for the competitions and for awards ceremonies.
