### **COVID-19 Preventative Measures**

Every team member officially named by the respective national ski association are obliged to present a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours upon accreditation. The PCR test presented, needs to be recognised by the health authority of the respective country! For all PCR tests it is necessary to indicate the time of taking the sample and the name.
