2. Rules

- The French freestyle Association and the Alpe d'Huez Committee are organising international FIS and Europa Cup Slope Style competitions, as part of the 2022 FIS Freeski Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- These competitions are **Slope Style events** for both men and women
- These competitions will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury

4. Registration and means of payment

5. Covid 19 Restrictions in France

The Organizing Committee will check the local Covid 19 restrictions on a daily base.

We will contact you in case any issues occur that might put the health of your team and the event in danger.

- At this time, December 15th 2021, all athletes and coaches must:
 - Provide European Agreed Vaccination
 - Or provide PCR Test less than 24h00
 - Or provide a certificate of healing (recovery of Covid between 14 days and 6 month)
- Daily Check of all kind of certificates.
- For people who have no certificates, the OC will ask a daily check of an antigenic Covid test to make at Pharmacy.
- European Sanitary Pass (with QR code) is mandatory to go to every Bar/restaurant in France.
- Face masks need to be worn in any closed rooms such as Hotels, Restaurants, Shops and also in the Gondola and Skilifts
- Maintain the distance of 1,5 meters in the waiting lines, etc. . .
- If any symptoms may occur, stay at home

For the safety and health of team and OC members, the event will be organized following the strict combined FIS Covid 19 protocol.

6. Team Captains Meeting

The first Team Captains meeting will be held online on Monday, 17th January at 18h00 in: **Tourist Office, Place Joseph Paganon, 38750, Alpe d'Huez** and then every evening at 18h00.

7. Lift tickets and Bibs

The lift tickets and bibs per nation (trainings and competitions) can be picked up at the **Snowpark Chalet, 2 minutes walk from the parking down the snowpark.**

An invoice for the Entry Fee per nation will be delivered with the bibs

All competitors must wear their bibs during trainings and competitions

Each Nations Team Captain will be responsible to return the bibs to the official at the end of the training or competition. Missing bibs will be charged with 50 € per bib

9. Bibs, Helmets and Liability

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10 € per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, la Clusaz, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participant are urged no to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

10. Accident Insurance & Protocol

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, la Clusaz, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.
