GENERAL INFORMATION

Accommodation

The accommodation for the FIS officials, team staff and athletes is in Otepää, Estonia. The hotels are located near the Tehvandi Sport Centre and it is about 10-15 min walk to the Tehvandi ski jumping hill.

The cost for full pension for one person per day is 95 € for double room. The full pension for single room for one person per day is 110 €. The payment will be done by the Organizing Committee only.

NOTE: We cannot guarantee any rooms or prices after **31st of May 2021**. For not used booked rooms, the organizer has the right to demand a cancellation fee from the National Ski Associations (FIS Cup Rules).

Transportation

The Organizing Committee can provide transportation to and from the **Tallinn Airport** upon request. The cost for one way is $40 \in$ per person. If you are travelling by your own transportation means, please announce your arrival time as well.

NOTE: Please send a confirmation for participation and the request for accommodation by the latest **31st of May 2021** and entry forms by the names send in by the latest **14th of June 2021** with transportation requests.

Waxing cabins are available. Key pick-up at Tehvandi Sport Center Hotel and the deposite is 50 € which will be refunded after the key has been returned

Covid-19 Regulations

Covid-19 PCR test must be done 72 hours before entering to Estonia. On the competition site it is forbidden to leave the hotel. It is only accepted to go to the ski jumping complex and back to the hotel. Wearing the mask is mandatory!
