1. Accreditation

- Requests for additional accreditation must be sent via the FIS Online System or to the OC Secretariat at kev@rukanordic.com.
- All accreditation cards can be picked up at: Accreditation Office in Hotel Scandic Rukahovi, Congress centre.

Opening times: daily from 09:00 to 19:00 (Mon-Thu), Fri 8-18, Sat 8-17, Sun 8-11.

2. Race Office

- The Race Office is located at Hotel Scandic Congress Centre

3. Accommodation

- Bookings according the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system

- The OC offers following accommodation (full board included):

-Three star hotel Scandic Rukahovi or Hotel RukaTonttu next to the venue:

112€ per person in double room, 147€ single

-Three star apartments (RukaTonttu, RukaSuites, AurinkoRinne, RukaVillage, Ruka Ski Chalets, Rukahovi apartments) next to the venue:

112€ per person (minimum number of person occur)

- Additional information about the accommodation will be given to the teams after receiving

preliminary entry and accommodation request

- Limited amount of accommodation available next to the venue, mainly for quota. For outside of the quota also self-catering holiday cottages /apartments at Ruka area also possible on request

- Price for additional accommodation outside of the quota: 117€ per person in double room or apartment (minimum number of person occur)

- Price for additional single rooms outside of the quota: 162€

- We retain the right for changes

4. Transport

- Official airport: Kuusamo and Oulu. The organizing committee will arrange transportation between the airports and the hotels. 1 transport (from and to the airport) free of charge.

- Prices for additional transport

260 € for Kuusamo airport (up to 15 persons =260 €, 16-50 p.=330 €)

770 € for Oulu airport (up to 15 persons = 770 €, 16-50 p.=940 €)

715 € for Rovaniemi airport (up to 15 persons = 715 €, 16-50 p.=885 €)

- Shuttle service: No shuttle service between hotels and venues (walking distance)



5. Payments

- Accommodation costs: Persons from the pay lists will be paid by the OC directly. For additional rooms, the teams will pay directly in the Accommodation Office until the 25th of November. Cash and credit cards accepted.

- Carrying costs/Reimbursement:

All payments will be done by electronically by bank transfer.

6. Waxing Facilities

- Wax cabins: available from 22/11/2021 at 12:00

- Waxing trucks: teams arriving with trucks must inform the OC until 15/10/2021 with exact measurements of the truck and details of the needs

- The keys to the cabins are available at the CC/SJ/NC sub-race office on the stadium. Keys return to CC/SJ/NC sub-race office/ Service Area on the day of departure.

- Parking cards can be picked up at the sub-race office together with the keys.

7. Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies:

The Finnish Transport and Communications Agency (Traficom) regulates the use of radio frequencies in Finland. Based on submitted applications Traficom issues radio licences for users of radio transmitters to ensure trouble-free utilisation of the radio spectrum. Applications can be submitted by filling in the form found with the link below no later than 31 October 2021.

12. Covid-19 instructions

- Before entering Finland, everyone should fill in their info at <https://www.finentry.fi/en/>. The service will provide information if any Covid tests are required before / when entering Finland. In general, everyone with a valid EU Covid-19 vaccination certificate, providing that the second vaccine is taken at minimum 14 days prior to arrival, can enter Finland without testing. For other cases, see detailed instructions here <https://raja.fi/en/guidelines-for-border-traffic-during-pandemic>
- FIS testing procedure will be applied for the teams. All team members are required to provide a negative PCR test result less than 72 hours older in FIS passport system before accreditation.
- Team members that have provided the information of the valid vaccination certification are not required follow-up testing during the event, except in the event of possible Covid-19 symptoms.
- Team members who do not have a valid vaccination certificate will be required follow-up testing during the event after 72 hours. The testing time will be informed separately. The test in Ruka will be an antigen test and the possible positive test result is confirmed with PCR test. The person with positive antigen test result will be quarantined until the PCR test result is received. In case the PCR result is positive, the local health authority can order a quarantine of 10 days (or longer if there are still symptoms after 10 days).
- Team members will be requested to fill in the daily FIS health questionnaire.
- The teams are separated from other groups in the event to ensure safe event experience. Accommodation, transportation etc. will be organized separately. Also hygiene measures like increased hygiene, safety distances and mask usage are in place.
