# **General Information**

## Transportation

The World Cup Head Office will provide transportation from and to the airport upon request. Please register online for this service.

## Accommodation

Accommodation bookings are handled by the World Cup Head Office Engelberg according to regulation. Only reservations which have been received by the deadline for pre-registration will be considered. The individual National Ski Associations are guaranteed accommodations only for the numbers of persons who were entered prior to the deadline.

Bookings cancelled after the final deadline (December 09, 2021) will incur a cancellation fee of up to 100% of the total costs, to be paid by the responsible National Ski Association.

### Gym

From December 16th to 19th 2021 teams will have full use of the local sports facility, if the conditions of the school allow it. It is free of charge and must be reserved in advance via <u>weltcup@engelberg.ch</u>. First come, first served - preference will be given according to when the registrations have been received. Keys to the facility must be collected at and returned to the Race Office.

### Price for the Fitness Center

Athletes can use the fitness centre at Sporting Park for the following prices: CHF 5.00 per athlete or CHF 80.00 per hour / room.

### **Prize Money**

The prize money will be paid according to the rules for the Ski Jumping World Cup (Men).

Per Qualification (Winner): CHF 3'000.00

Per single competition: CHF 71'800.00

The prize money will be disbursed by bank transfer. Therefore, winners must submit the following bank details to the race office after each event: IBAN, BIC and UID.

### **Travel Costs**

Expenses and travel costs will be reimbursed at the Race Office.

### Catering at the hill

The catering for athletes, trainers and staff will be provided at least 1 hour before the official training / competition times at the athlete's tent at the jumping hill area. During all competition days the lunch and dinner will be served in the hotel. Due to that there will be a to minimum reduced catering at the athlete's tent.

## **Radio Frequencies**

### Application for a temporary radio licence

The Organizing Committee was informed that the Federal Office of Communications (OFCOM) will conduct an official on-site frequency





usage check on the occasion of the ski jumping event in Engelberg 2021. We ask you to check whether your equipment (radio transmission equipment of any kind) is subject to registration or concession in accordance with Swiss law. ## **Covid-19 measures**

The local organising committee, together with the National Ski Association Swiss-Ski, is currently drawing up the generally applicable guidelines and measures for the organisation of World Cup events in Switzerland.

#### **General Remarks**

- · Masks are compulsory in all official areas and accreditation zones.
- As of today, admission to the site is only valid with a valid Covid certificate.
- No free / unofficial trainings are offered.
- The FIS Ski Jumping World Cup Engelberg 2021 will take place with spectators and with FIS family members.

#### Entry into Switzerland

- All participants involved, in particular the national ski federations for the participating athletes, coaches and support staff, are responsible for their own entry into Switzerland.
- Everyone entering Switzerland must present an entry form. If you are not vaccinated or recovered, you must also show proof of a negative test. Please contact the Swiss foreign representations in the respective country early enough.
- Travellers by air are recommended to inform themselves about the local regulations at the Swiss airport of arrival before departure.
- Passengers travelling by public transport (e.g. train) are subject to the general obligation to wear a mask on the entire rail system from the Swiss national border at the latest.
- For travellers with individual transportation (private car or team bus) there are currently no further protective measures apart from the general rules of conduct.

#### Arrival to and departure from Engelberg

- Arrival to and departure from Engelberg, with the exception of the organised airport transfer, is done individually and is basically at your own responsibility.
- Generally avoid intermediate stops on your way to and from the airport. If, however, stopovers are unavoidable, the respective country-specific safety measures must be followed.
- The airport transfer to and from Engelberg is organised by the organiser and is primarily provided by an appointed taxi company. The Swiss taxi companies follow the national public transport regulations. Apart from the general rules of conduct, they have no restrictions on the limited number of people they can transport.

#### Support

The national association Swiss-Ski is currently examining the possibility of a standardised entry regulation to Switzerland for athletes, trainers, coaches and officials. The local organising committee FIS Ski Jumping World Cup Engelberg 2020 is making every effort to provide all participating national ski federations with the best possible support for entry. Currently, the <u>general entry regulations of the Federal Office of Public Health (BAG) apply.</u>
