Each NSA bears the responsibility that their entered competitors have signed FIS Athletes' Declaration, and have an ACTIVE FIS Masters Code Number. Athletes and coaches are responsible for their own insurance. It is necessary to have and ACTIVE FIS Masters code. Competitor competes on their own responsibility.
Entries:	3,000 Yen per race (20.00 Euro equivalent) Please pay at race registration. The official FIS Entry form must be used for the registration. On registration form, it must be written compete for 1st or 2nd SL race or both, and contain the FIS code.
