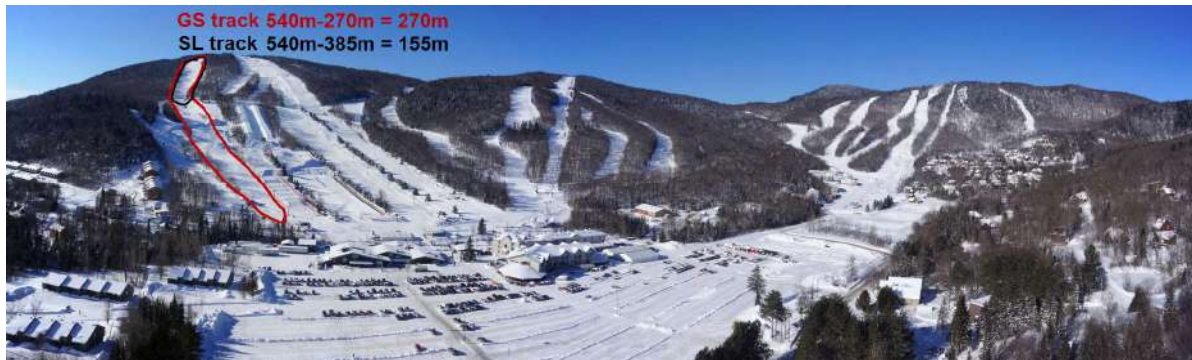
for any accident or loss that could occur during the events. The jury has the right to refuse participation of any competitor who may constitute a potential risk under these circumstances.

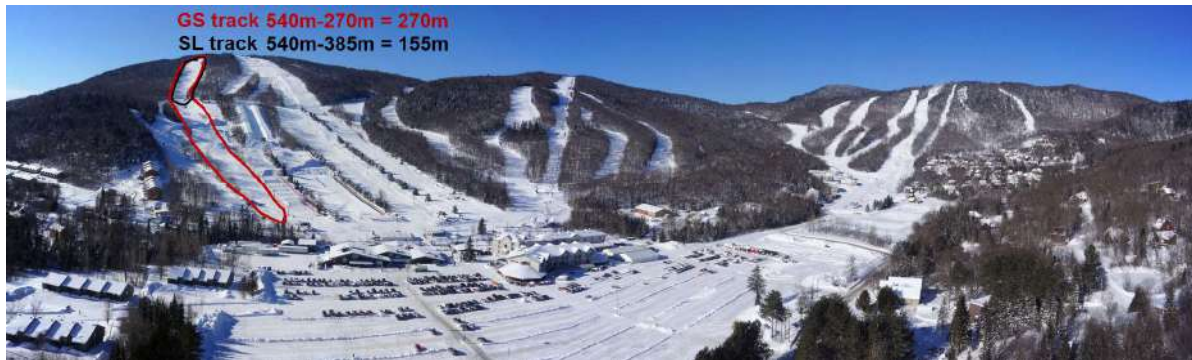
