COVID-19 Prevention guidelines:

1) General safety and hygiene rules in the sports facility

- a. The present COVID-19 prevention concept was developed on the basis of the current COVID-19 measures law in connection with the currently valid COVID-19 relaxation regulations and COVID-19 recommendations for action of the ministries. For all COVID-19- preventive measures Elmar Egg is classified as prevention representative of the organizer.
- b. Participation is only possible with a valid certificate (tested-vaccinated-recovered). The proof must be presented at the race office and must be valid for the entire event.
 - The vaccination certificate, a confirmation from the doctor and the EU's "green pass" are valid as proof of vaccination. From the day of complete immunization (second vaccination), the vaccination certificate is valid for 9 months (ATTENTION: first vaccination is no longer sufficient). Vaccines for which only one vaccination is intended (e.g. from Johnson & Johnson) are valid from the 22nd day after the vaccination, also for 9 months from the day of the vaccination.
 - If you have recovered from a Coronavirus infection within the last six months, please bring a confirmation from your doctor or the official notice to self-isolate with you. Alternatively, proof of antibodies no more than three months old is also applicable.
 - PCR tests and rapid antigen tests are permissible for testing. PCR tests are valid for 72 hours, rapid official antigen tests and supervised self-tests for 48 hours.
- c. Masks are mandatory in the gondola, in the race office and in all other indoor areas
- d. We advise all participants to keep a minimum distance of 1 meter between persons in indoor and outdoor areas.
- e. The competition will be closed to the spectators just participate athletes and responsible team coaches allowed to stay at event facilities.
- f. Athletes, service-staff/coaches and other persons present at the competition sites, who show symptoms of illness, are not allowed to enter the facilities/areas for training and competition.
- g. It is requested to carry out fever scans and superficial health checks and interviews with the teams on own responsibility before arrival. Should symptoms of illness be detected, participation is to be refrained and the organizer is to be informed.
- h. Each team captain is responsible for ensuring that contact tracing can take place in the event of an infection

2) Security measures in the region

- a. The health of our guests is very important to us and that is why Montafon has been doing everything to ensure a safe stay in our regions since the beginning of the Covid 19 pandemic. You can find all the important information about this topic at www.montafon.at/corona.
- b. As long as proof (vaccinated, tested, recovered) can be presented upon entering the country, no entry registration (pre-travel clearance) is necessary. If no such proof can be presented, it is mandatory to take a test within 24 hours in Austria and fill in the <u>pre-travel clearance form (if possible electronically)</u> before entering the country.
- c. Please note that a valid certificate must be presented upon arrival at the accommodation
- d. Regardless of whether you want to visit restaurants, the theatre, football grounds or the swimming pool: the safety formula "vaccinated, tested or recovered" applies everywhere.









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3) Testing facilities in the Montafon

As part of the various test offers, either rapid antigen tests or PCR tests are carried out or supervised. If you need a test for entry or return to a certain country, make sure whether you need a PCR test or whether a rapid antigen test is sufficient! You can find all the important information about this topic at www.montafon.at/coronatest.

4) Measures in case of suspicion

- a) If a COVID-19 suspected case is known during the event, the person concerned must immediately contact the COVID-19 representative and the COVID-19 representative must immediately locate the suspected case. All further steps/measures (separation, grounding, cancellation, etc.) must be carried out in coordination with the COVID-19 representative.
- b) If a COVID-19 suspected case becomes known after the event, it must be reported immediately to the COVID-19 representative.

All persons involved in the competition must comply with the above measures. The organizer can expel people or groups from the event site at any time if they do not adhere to the measures. This Covid-19 measures were determined as at Aug 18th 2021 and can be adjusted depending on the situation and expanded.
