Accomondation

Reservation of accommodations according to nations quota only. Accommodation must be registered by 05 December 2021. For room reservations cancelled after the registration deadline, a cancellation fee of 100% of the applicable costs must be paid by the relevant national association. Accommodation will take place after registration in hotels booked by the organiser. The hotels must submit to the organiser a hygiene concept approved by the Health Office. There are mainly single rooms or double rooms with separate beds available. In addition, each accommodation has 2 isolation rooms for COVID-19 suspected cases and positively tested persons.

Transportation

The OK organises a limited shuttle service. Teams are asked to travel with their own or rented vehicles to restrict contacts

Accreditation Office:

Accreditation is only issued to persons who can present a negativ PCR test, which is not older than 72 hours (calculated from the time of the smear) upon collection. This may be submitted in electronic or written form. In addition, a completed form with the contact details must be provided to track any infection chains.

Team accreditations are collected from a representative of the team collected. Access to the accreditation office is carried out individually. This is coordinated during opening hours by a security force at the entrance. Wearing a mouth-nose cover in the accreditation office is mandatory.

COVID-19 REGULATIONS

For the event, a hygiene concept based on the Saxon Corona Protection Ordinance and the general decree of the district Vogtland for the implementation of the Infection Protection Act (IfSG) will be prepared. The event will only take place subject to approval of the hygiene concept by the competent health authority. The concept will be published after approval.

NOTES ON INFECTION PROTECTION MEASURES

- · Access to the competition venues (jumping facility as well as start and finish area) is blocked off and controlled.
- Only accredited persons are allowed access.
- Persons with symptoms of infection are not allowed in the venue.
- Only athletes and stuff, officials, judges and volunteers, whose personal data are recorded, are accredited. Without accreditation, it is forbidden to enter the premises.
- · Spectators are allowed.
- Media representatives will only be allowed with a negative Covid-19 test, which is not older than 72 hours.

ALLGEMEINE HYGIENEREGELN / MUND-NASEN-SCHUTZ

Compliance with hygiene measures (hand disinfection, cough and sneezing hygiene, minimum distance of 1.5m) must be taken into account. Dispensers with disinfectants for hand-des-infection are provided. The signs of the organizer at the competition venues must be observed.

Wearing a mouthguard on the event grounds is mandatory. (except athletes - in the sub-discipline jump: mask obligation up to step control and from exit of the outlet - in the subdiscipline run: mask obligation until entering the starting area and from leaving the target area)

Only employees of the race office and one person per association is allowed to enter the race office building. Here, too, there is a duty to wear masks.

Only members of the competition management, jury members (including race secretary), judges, members of the data service and the calculation office are allowed to stay in the referee's tower. When staying in the judges tower, mask scare sobs apply to all persons as a matter of principle!

For the trainers, mask duty applies in principle to the coaching stand! The number of trainers who are allowed to stay in the coaching gallery is limited in accordance with the minimum level.

In the start-up area of the hill, accumulations are to be avoided! Only a certain number of athletes in the starting area is allowed

The start and finish area for the cross-country skiing competition must be closed off. Access is controlled. Only athletes with a race number and persons marked as judges have access. For the judges in the start and finish area, mask duty applies in principle!
