Competition Rules

FIS rules will be applied to this competition

COVID-19 SITUATION

In order to ensure the health and safety for the athletes and team personnel, the LOC is working in accordance with the Regional and National Health regulations as well as with FIS in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines together with the World Health Organisation (WHO) information and recommendations.

The LOC and FIS Event Task Force has been established and is monitoring all developments. The corresponding arrangements are currently being put together in a separate document (red bubble, testing protocol,...). This will be published and communicated by the LOC at a later stage.

All competitors must have their own medical insurance (ICR art 212) which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment expenses. Updated COVID-19 relevant medical procedures that may be required will be communicated.

Entries

Entries will be accepted only from National Ski Associations via the FIS entry system following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants as per rule 4.2 in the Rules for the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cups.

The preliminary number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than the **30th of October 2021**.



The names of participants must be submitted via the FIS entry system no later than the **29th November 2021 (Final Entries)** as per rule 4.2.1 in the Rules for the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cups.

Access to the online registration system is through FIS Homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com> then go to Member Section.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Snowboard Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded:

Accomodation and Wax Rooms

Teams will be hosted for lodging and meals at different partner hotels as per the FIS Snowboard World Cup rules (6 nights at the FIS rate, CHF 80,-) from Monday, December 6th to Sunday December 12th. Earlier arrivals or later departures than the official arriving/departure day do not guarantee the FIS rate. Tourism tax is between € 1,80 and € 2,40 per night and person.

Official Arriving Day: 6th December 2021

Official Departure Day: 12th December 2021

As per the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cup Rules on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials will pay the Euro equivalent of 80 Swiss Francs per day. The tourism tax has to be paid extra (between € 1,80 and € 2,40 per night and person).

Each coach has to pay his/her team accommodation expenses on arrival day. No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. Wax rooms will be at all partner hotels.

Cancellation before one week of the first training day are free of charge.

Cancellation 6 days or less before the first training day can be charged individually by the hotel.

Registration / Race Office

Team registration will take place daily starting on Monday 6th January at the Alpine Sport Center. This year, all accreditations are personalized. The accreditation can only be created by registering in the FIS entry system. The accreditation can only be issued after submitting all COVID-relevant documents via the FIS Passport (information will be submitted later). One representative per team can collect all accreditations.

Participation Fee

A mandatory Participation Fee (competitors only) of a maximum of CHF 30 per official training and competition day (including team events) will be charged to all entered competitors, based on the program in the official invitation. The invitation should clearly state the total amount to be paid by each competitor and event. The total amount cannot be more than CHF 120 per competitor.



Double participation: the participation fee only has to be paid once (e.g. 2x Training-, 1 Qualification-, 1 Final day) or respectively up to the maximum of CHF 120.

Payment

The Participation Fee has to be paid at the Alpine Sport Center in cash or credit card.

TC Meetings

The Team Captains meeting will be in the Alpine Sport Center. Please see the schedule for meeting times. First TC Meeting will be on Monday 6th December. If necessary the TCM will take place digital by Zoom.

Medical and Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping control testing maybe conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

FIS Licence

All athletes are required to have a valid FIS license.

Press Center

The Press Center will be located at the Alpine Sport Center

Ceremonies, Public Draw, Side Events

Please see schedule for the Ceremonies, Public Draw & Side Events times. Top 3 women and top 3 men need to attend the award ceremony right after the final run in the finish area.



Rules

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule of the event stated in the program, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.

Bibs

The competitors wear bibs during trainings, competition and award ceremonies. Please note that there will be a deposit of € 20,- for each bib, payable only in cash at the race office.

Transportations/Directions

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

PRIZE MONEY

The prize money breakdown is in accordance with the FIS rules and all money transfers will be made electronically within 7 business days after the event. In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to review and doublecheck the bank account information for each athlete at the FIS Member Section on the FIS Website.
