## COVID-19 NOTE

We are currently in the procedure of establishing COVID-19 safe areas and procedures for all of you during the event. This work is in progress in close cooperation with both the FIS and the Czech NSA, as well as with medical and other specialists in the field. The system we shall implement will allow you to participate at the event in a COVID-19-safe 'bubble' during your entire stay, without lacking any standards or quality of execution for the contests. As a consequence of any safe system, a few strict rules will be inevitable. They mainly concern your whereabouts during the event (such as rules for mountain and lift transportation, meals, avoiding non-riders areas, online TC meetings etc.). All our efforts are driven to keep you safe from the moment you set foot in Spindleruv Mlyn event until you depart after the event. More detailed information shall be available in due time ahead of the event.

### Registration and Accreditation

Registration and accreditation will be held in the race office situated in the official accommodation hotel Horal beginning March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the Registration Area for check in before proceeding to the slopestyle competition venues.

All fees will be collected upon check in. The AMEX cards are not accepted.

Participation Fee: According to the FIS World Cup Rules a mandatory Participation fee of CHF 30 per each competitor for training, qualification and competition day has to be paid but not more than CHF 120 or equivalent in CZK

### TC meeting

Team captain's meeting will be held first day 14<sup>th</sup> March at 20:00 in the Race Office – Hotel Horal. Please make sure that only one person per nation participates physically. There might be the possibility to participate online.

### Accommodation

Accommodation with the half board will be provided in OREA Hotel Horal Spindleruv Mlyn\*\*\*\* <http://www.orea.cz/en/orea-hotel-horal>. All Teams and Team members must stay in the official hotel to be able to assure COVID safe surroundings.

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half board, all competitors and team officials will pay the Organizing Committee (in cash or credit card) 80 CHF or an equivalent in CZK per day, accommodation for the FIS rate will be provided from Monday 14.3. till Sunday 20.3.2022. The team coaches have to pay the whole amount up on arrival, no reservations and/or payments will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

Single room(s) per team will be provided according to the table outlined in the Snowboard World Cup rules. It is the responsibility of the team to determine who receives the room(s). Any additional single rooms beyond quota requested will be provided

only if available and at a market rate.

Market rate for additional single rooms or early arrival is 140 CHF/night.

These conditions will be applied to anyone registered through the online entry system, which must be submitted to the Organizing Committee by January 17<sup>th</sup> ???, 2022 the latest.

The accommodation changes must be submitted to the OC not later than by March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, after this date the cancellation fee of 80% will be applied. If there is a no show, 100% will be applied.

All the accommodation must be booked over the FIS Online Registration System.

To be eligible for participation in the FIS Snowboard World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a valid FIS Code. All fees and deposits must be paid in cash (CZK/CHF) or credit card upon registration. Please make sure that the credit cards are accessible

for the payments in the Czech Republic location (we accept Master card, VISA, VISA Electron, we do not accept AMEX cards).

### **Bibs**

All competitors must wear bibs during all official trainings, competition and award ceremonies.

### **Prize Money**

The winners will receive prize money via bank transfer not later than 7 days after the last competition as per FIS WC Rule 1.2.10. NSAs are responsible for entering the personal bank information for each athlete using the Athlete Registration module in the FIS Member Section.
