Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski and Snowboard Associations following FIS World Cup quotas and rules. Please submit the provisional entry with anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by 29th November 2021. The final entry with number of your competition team and names of participants (including competitors and official) must be submitted to the organizers no later than 29th December, 2021.

Onsite registration / Accreditation

Registration and accreditation will be held at the accreditation office in the Seminar Room of the Hotel Belvédère, Stradun 330, the office is signed, in Scuol. Please see schedule for registration times. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the registration area for check-in before proceeding to the competition venues. All fees will be collected upon check-in.

Athlete Participation Fee: CHF 30.00 per competitor only cash and credit card can be accepted at accreditation office.

Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during competition and at the awards ceremony.

Covid – 19 Prevention Guide Lines

In order to ensure the health and safety for the athletes and team personnel, the LOC is working in accordance with the Regional and National Health regulations as well as with FIS in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines together with the World Health Organisation (WHO) information and recommendations. The LOC and FIS Event Task Force has been established and is monitoring all developments. The corresponding arrangements are currently being put together in a separate document. This will be published and communicated by the LOC at a later stage. All competitors must have their own medical insurance (ICR art 212) which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment expenses. Updated COVID-19 relevant medical procedures that may be required will be communicated whenever relevant.

Onsite, registration & accreditation will be possible after a Covid-19 check-in. Please bring your COVID-19-check-in verification to the accreditation office, located in the Hotel Belvedere. Only one person for each team can come to the accreditation. All fees will be collected upon check-in. Please make sure you can pay cashless, i.e. with a bank or credit card. All the documents have to be uploaded at least 12 hours before you get the accreditation.
