WORLD CUP EVENT/ ENTRIES

DEADLINE ENTRIES

Entries for both competitions (Freeski & Snowboard) will be accepted from National Ski Association according to the FIS quotas and rules. The number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the name of participants must be submitted to the Organizing Committee within the following deadlines:

Preliminary Deadline:

Freeski World Cup: January 23rd, 2022

Snowboard World Cup: January 24th, 2022

If field sizes are over the maximum numbers, cuts will be applied according to the FIS WC rules.

Final Deadline:

Freeski World Cup: March 14th, 2022

Snowboard World Cup: March 15th, 2022

On both deadlines the names of the athletes must be registered.

LOCATION

Silvaplana (1815m) with its ski resort Corvatsch (up to 3303m) is located in the Engadine, Switzerland. Engadine is a famous valley in the Southern Alps with a long skiing tradition and St. Moritz as its main town. The slopestyle course will be located at 2700m high altitude.

SLOPESTYLE COURSE

Construction Crew

Kobi has years of experience in course designing, snow park building and cat driving and has been supporting the Corvatsch for the World Cup and many other events since a long time. CATERING

All athletes and coaches will receive a warm meal per day for lunch on their official training and competition days (Tuesday to Sunday).

TRANSPORT

Teams are responsible for their own transport. There are several airports in more or less the same distance to Engadine valley: **Zurich** (CH); **Milan** (IT); and **Innsbruck** (AT).

All these airports are 3 to 3.5 hours car driving to Silvaplana. If you are travelling with public transport, it is preferable to choose Zurich airport (4 hours travel by train).

From Zurich airport you can find the best connection to the final train station St. Moritz on the website <https://www.sbb.ch/en/home.html>. From the train station to your accommodation there is a taxi service in front of the train station as well as a bus service (the timetable is available on the same website by entering the accommodation address).

REQUIREMENTS COVID-19

During the FIS Freeski & Snowboard World Cup (Corvatsch, Silvaplana) all FIS and Swiss Ski Covid-19 requirements apply.

ONSITE ACCREDITATION

The onsite accreditation starts on Monday, 21st March 2022.

The race office is located at the Corvatsch valley station. The opening times are listed in the detailed schedule (see last pages of this document) and on our website:

All persons to be accredited must:

1. Register on the FIS Passport Portal by Thursday, March 17th 2022
2. Upload a PCR-test valid for 72 hours before the accreditation time (start of accreditation is on Monday, March 21st 2022 at 14:00 CET).
3. (after being accredited) reply daily to the FIS Health Questionnaire to keep the accreditation active.

ADMINISTRATION FEE

Every competitor has to pay **CHF 120 administration fee** at the registration. The payment can be made with credit card or cash (Swiss Francs only).

LIFT TICKETS

All athletes and coaches will get **free lift tickets** during the World Cup week, from Tuesday March 22nd to Sunday, March 27th 2022.

Teams who would like to ski on Corvatsch during the winter season, before or after the World Cup, are offered the following prices upon presentation of the official letter from the belonging National Ski Association:

Adults (13+): CHF 55.-

Youth, 6-12: CHF 30.-

All competitors must wear bibs during training, the competition and the awards ceremony.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money for Corvatsch FIS Freeski & Snowboard World Cup Slopestyle will be **50'000.- CHF per discipline** (CHF 100'000.- in total and 25'000.- CHF per gender).
