Each competitor must have a national license and must have signed the FIS athlete's declaration.

SAFETY

Each participant is responsible for his or her own safety during the race and, by signing the participant's declaration, confirms with his signature that he is aware of the risks and assumes responsibility for his safety. During the competition, you must wear a pearl. It is also desirable to use back and knees protectors.

PARTICIPATION FEE AND LIFT TICKET

The participation fee is 10 euro per discipline or 20 euro for both big air and slopestyle.

Lift tickets can be bought at the venue. Price for 2 days lift ticket: 40 euro this is a special price only for competitors and coaches.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Slopestyle competition will have qualification and final competition. Competitors will have a chance to do 2 runs of which 1 best will count for the final result.

Big air competitions will have qualification and final competitions. Competitors will have a chance to do 3 jumps of which 2 will sum for the final result. It has to be two different tricks.
