Athletes: Lift Tickets for training and competition days will be offered at 40% discount. Vouchers will be provided at Sign In and will be purchased at Guest Services.

Coaches: Lift Tickets will be comped based on 5 athletes to 1 coach pass. Coaches not qualifying for comp pass will receive 40% discount voucher.
