SPEED NATION Alpine SKI CLUB

Speed Nation Alpine Ski Club is the third Stop of the Speed Nation Alpine Tour.

Speed Nation Alpine Ski Club brings together the best Alpine athletes in North America to compete in two Parallel Slalom events in two days.

THE RESORT

Alpine Ski Club's 120 acres and 760 feet of elevation are home to 36 runs served by five lifts. (A short 90 minute drive from the Pearson International airport). The terrain advances in difficulty lift by lift from a protected beginner area with a magic carpet (and clubhouse gallery seating) to five double-black expert runs aptly named The Steeps. A high-speed six-person chair and three quad chairs keep the lift lines short, especially in light of capped membership.

Eligibility

Competitors must meet the following age limit to compete:
NorAm / FIS Events - 15 years+ old by December 31, 2021

Competitors must hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial or Territorial Snowboard Association Membership before registering through your Provincial or Territorial Association.
