#### THE RESORT

Beaver Valley is located on the 30 minutes outside of Collingwood and less than two hours from Toronto Pearson International Airport. Set overlooking the Beaver Valley offers twenty six groomed trails, progression and terrain parks, mogul course as well as a dedicated SBX track. Their facilities include a high capacity snowmaking system allowing for earlier opening dates as well as four efficient lifts and club house lodges. A team of expert builders will complete the building of the Beaver Valley NorAm track with oversight provided by Canada Snowboard and Snowboard Ontario.
