COVID-19 SITUATION

The event is subject to the current Corona 3G regulation. (3G = recovered, vaccinated or tested - both PCR tests / 72 hours – as well as antigen tests / 24 hours) 3G will then also apply again in cable cars, sports facilities, gastronomy and Accommodation. PCR tests can be taken and handed in at the respective accommodation as well as at M Preis shops. The evaluation takes at least 24 hours.

The Teams are eligible to participate as follows:

A daily health report is to be submitted - details will be sent to the TC of the named teams. The TC confirms compliance with the Covid guidelines for his team.

The use of the FIS Passport for the EC an the COVID Passport for the FIS Jun event is mandatory - Apply for the event via <https://fispassport.fis-ski.com/fis/portal>.

The face masks will be required in all indoor locations. Please use the disinfection and wash your hands frequently. Stay 1,5 m from the others. In case of any medical problems, please be responsible, report your medical condition to the OC and stay out of the competition loop, in order to prevent eventual COVID spread.
