## **Arriving in France**

## Visas regulations

Citizens of the European Union (Germany, Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Denmark, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Estonia,

Finland, France, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, United Kingdom,

Czech Republic, Romania and Sweden), European Economic Area (Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway) or Switzerland do not need a visa to enter the country.

The following countries do not require a visa for visits lasting less than 90 days, but require a valid passport to enter France: Andorra, Antigua and Bermuda, Argentina, Bahamas, Barbados, Bolivia, Bosnia, Brunei, Canada, Chile, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Hong Kong, Israel, Japan, Korea, Macao, Malaysia, Mauritius, Mexico, Monaco, Montenegro, Nicaragua, New Zealand, Panama, Paraguay, Saint Kitts and Nevis, San Marino, Serbia, Seychelles, Singapour, Taiwan, Uruguay and Venezuela.

For citizens of countries not previously mentioned, we recommend visit the France visas website.

Wether needing a visa or not, all individuals entering or leaving the country must comply with the eventual Covid-19 complementary measures and controls. At time of publication, no such measures are enforced but that may change as the epidemic situation evolves. Please check the <u>French Ministry of Foreign Affairs website</u> for the updated situation and corresponding requirements.

### **Transport**

Official airport : Geneva

!!! Geneva is in Switzerland, therefore additional visa requirements and Covid-19 regulations may apply for those traveling by plane.

Please check the Swiss State Secretariat for Migration website for more information.

The Organizing committee will arrange transportation between Geneva airport and hotels if requested. 1 transport (from and to the airport) free of charge.

Shuttle service between hotels and competition site will be organized according to the teams request with coaches or minibus.

#### Special permissions for truck driving (Sunday and night, other days with special regulations)

- In France most trucks over 7.5 tonnes are banned from the French road and motorway network every weekend between the hours of 10 p.m Saturday and 10 p.m Sunday but there is a permanent exception for trucks servicing sporting events. A confirmation of participation from our OC will be delivered to all teams coming with a waxing truck, accompanied by the French law text granting that exception (arrêté du 16 avril 2021, article 4, part 3°a) as justification in case of a control.
- In Switzerland, driving is prohibited for all vehicles over 3.5t (except the transport of persons), articulated vehicles and road trains of over 5t on Sundays from 00:00 to 24:00 as well as at night from 22:00 to 05:00. Derogations for foreign vehicles may be issued by the Office Fédéral des routes, Centre d'intervention Gothard, PO Box, CH 6487 Göschenen; Tel: (+41 41) 885 03 20 / Fax: (+41 41) 885 03 21; e-mail: sonderbewilligung@astra.admin.ch; www.sonderbewilligung.ch
- In Italy, driving is prohibited on Sunday from 08:00 to 22:00 for vehicles with an authorized total weight of over 7.5t. Application for derogation must be submitted at least 10 days in advance to the prefecture of the province of departure or of entry into Italy.

#### Accommodation

Booking according to the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system.

The OC offers accommodation in three star hotels with prices ranging from 106€ (115CHF) to 115€ (125CHF) /pers/night in twin rooms.

Hotels in Station Les Rousses are mainly small hotels therefore we are working with hotels within reasonable distance of the stadium to have sufficient capacity. Attribution of hotels are on a "first come, first serve" basis from the closest to the furthest

### **Accreditation**

## Reimbursement & Prize money

Due to data protection rules, all athlete's information have to be directly given to the financial office <u>finances.jse@gmail.com</u> or in the finances office on site.

- · Accommodation costs will be paid directly to the OC at the finances office.
- Carrying costs/reimbursement: all payment will be done by bank transfer. Teams must provide the bank information to the OC through the FIS.
- Prize money: due to French income tax, the gross amount of the prize money will be reduced of 15%. Each athlete is responsible for providing his/her bank information to the OC through the FIS.

## **Waxing facilities**

Wax cabins are available from 23rd January 2023 at 14:00.

Keys to the cabin are available at the entrance of the team village. A deposit of 50€ per key is requested.

Teams arriving with waxing trucks have to inform the OC before December 13th 2022 of their needs.

### **Medical Service**

In case of emergency outside the stadium, public emergency number is 112 (European Emergency number).

At the venue, a doctor is present during the whole competitions at the first aid station, next to the teams compound. The number for this station will be communicated to the teams upon arrival on site.

## Health protection plan

Information subject to changes according to the evolution of the pandemic : please check updated information on our website.

At time of publication, no Covid-19 passes or specific measures are enforced beyond those relating to general safety. Viruses (Covid or others) do not spread on their own therefore the barrier measures are still strongly encouraged:

- Respect social distancing: you should remain further than two meters from others;
- Wear a mask where necessary (see below);
- Wash your hands very often or use hydro-alcoholic gel;
- Use single-use tissues, and then throw them away;
- Cough and sneeze into your arm or into a tissue;



- · Limit social contacts as much as possible;
- Do not shake hands or greet people with kisses on the cheek;
- · Avoid touching your face;
- · Air rooms for at least ten minutes, three times a day;
