COMPETITION RULES

This competition, for both men and women, will be held under the FIS Cross World Cup rules. All national associations affiliated to FIS are invited to compete. This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants. The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, or by the decision of the competition jury.

COVID-19 SITUATION

Should COVID-19 guidelines be necessary we will submit them at a later date.

REGISTRATION - ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page within the mentioned deadlines: www.fis-ski.com/"Member Section". FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. Entries by mail or fax are no longer accepted.

Provisional Entries: Sunday January 22nd, 2023

Each National Association has to announce to the Organisers the expected total number of team members (competitors, coaches, accompanying persons and service personnel) by the deadlines fixed and announced (40 days before the first competition day)

Teams or persons who register late have no right for the reservation or the guarantee of the rate in rule 4.2.1.

This needs to be done using the "Competition Online Entry System".

Confirmation of Final Entries: Tuesday, February 21st, 2023

Not later than 10 days before the 1st competition day the NSA must inform the OC of its final entries (Names, FIS Code and Gender) with their arrival and departure dates. The NSA must also inform the OC about the arrival and departure dates of the team officials.

Adjustments to final competitor entries and rooming needs can be done up until the entry deadline (10 days before the competition day). The same can be done for Team Officials.

Any changes in entries or rooming will be confirmed by email from the Online Entry System to the Organiser and Team.

The change of the entire team ratio (competitors, officials, service personnel) may not exceed 20% of the original number. Teams that exceed 20% have no right for the reservation or the guarantee of the official rate. For Teams which cancel more than 20% the organiser may ask a cancellation fee up to the official room rate for the cancellations exceeding the 20%. The Organiser may invoice the costs incurred WC Rules23.doc/06.07.2022 Page 35 of 56 for cancelled accommodation to the National Association concerned.



REGISTRATION / RACE OFFICE

Team registration will take place daily, starting on Tuesday 28th February 2023 at the Race Office, located at the LGO Liftgesellschaft mbH / Vierenstr. 3b / 09484 Kurort Oberwiesenthal.

ACCOMODATION AND WAX ROOMS

Teams will be hosted for lodging and meals at different partner hotels as per the FIS World Cup rules (6 nights at the FIS rate, CHF 60,- per day) from Tuesday 28th February to Monday 6th March. The FIS rate can only be guaranteed if the teams book the rooms via the official entries until 21th February 2023.

The LOC does not cover the costs of independent bookings by the teams.

Earlier arrivals or later departures than the official arriving/departure day do not guarantee the FIS rate.

Official Arriving Day: Tuesday 28th February 2023

Official Departure Day: Sunday 6th March 2023

Each coach has to pay his/her team accommodation expenses on arrival day at the race office, located at the LGO Liftgesellschaft mbH / Vierenstr. 3b / 09484 Kurort Oberwiesenthal.

ATTENTION –TAX FOR ALL LODGING ESTABLISHMENTS

The local tax will be levied at ALL LODGING ESTABLISHMENTS, on a per-guest and per-overnight-stay basis and has nothing to do with the FIS Rate of the accommodation. The local tax is listed separately on the invoice.

No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

Two single rooms per country will be provided at CHF 60.

3 additional single rooms requested will be provided at the rate of CHF 100 per night.

For Wax rooms we offer a Waxing Center in Oberwiesenthal which will be located round 1.2km away from the Course.

MEDICAL AND ANTI - DOPING

Anti-Doping control testing maybe conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

FIS LICENCE

All athletes are required to have a valid FIS license.

RULES

BIBS

The competitors must wear bibs during trainings, competition and award ceremonies.

PRESS CENTER

The Press Center will be located near to the course. The exact location will be announced later.

CEREMONIES, PUBLIC DRAW

Please see schedule for the Ceremonies, Public Draw & Side Events times. The competitors MUST wear bibs during the official training, competition and prize giving ceremony! Top 3 ladies and top 3 men need to attend the award directly after the final run in the finish area.
