2. Rules

- The French freestyle Association and the Alpe d'Huez Committee are organising international FIS and Europa Cup Moguls and Dual Moguls competitions, part of the 2023 FIS Moguls Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- These competitions are **Moguls and Dual Moguls events** for both men and women
- These competitions will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, number of competitors or the decision of the competition jury

3. Entries

Entries will be accepted from the National Ski Associations in accordance with the official FIS Entry Form within the FIS quotas for EC 2.2.2

The entries for this event must be done on the FIS On line Entry system (Member section) before :

Preliminary ENTRY : February 2nd, 2023

Final ENTRY : March 3rd, 2023

6. Lift tickets and Bibs

The lift tickets and bibs per nation (for trainings) can be picked up at the Race Office
For the 2 competitions lift tickets and bibs can be picked up at the bottom of the
"Telemix du Signal"

An invoice for the Entry Fee per nation will be delivered with the bibs.

All competitors must wear their bibs during trainings and competitions.

Each Nations Team Captain will be responsible to return the bibs to the official at the end of the training or competition. Missing bibs will be charged with 30 € per bib.

Teams are free to book the accommodation of their choice.

Please notice that our event will take place during a busy period, so we recommend all the teams to check the accommodation availability as soon as possible.

8. Bibs and Helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 30 € per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

9. Liability

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, Alpe d'Huez ski resort, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

10. Accident Insurance & Protocol

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, les Arcs, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.

11. Covid 19 Restrictions in France

There are currently no covid rules and guidelines from the French Government or from the FIS. We shall plan accordingly of any new Covid situation new rules and regulations required (from FIS or French government) between now and the event.

12. Prize Money

Prize money will be awarded at each FIS Europa Cup competition based on the total number of competitors entered into a Europa Cup event in Aerials and Moguls.

The total prize money available for each event will be determined by CHF 10 x the total number of competitors starting in each event. Prize Money is calculated separately for each event and the total prize money is split equally between women and men. An organiser is permitted to award more prize money in excess of the formula.

Prize money will be according to the following percentage of the Total Prize Money per event and taking into consideration the local tax laws:

1st place = 50%

2nd place = 30%

3rd place = 20%

In the case where supplemental prize money is provided the OC is allowed to determine the breakdown of percentages of prize money in excess of the minimum dictated by the rule above.

Prize money is paid to the athletes at the end of each competition day. The amount of prize money will be calculated and announced at the draw before each competition at the TC meeting. The OC must assist the competitors with matters relating to taxation for prize money awarded in the country in which the competition is held.
