**Rules**

- ▲ FIS Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Championships St. Moritz Engadin 2025 and Swiss Ski are organizing a FIS Freestyle Ski competition, part of the 2022-2023 Continental Cup of the International Ski Federation (FIS) Tour.
- ▲ The dates for this competition have been published in the FIS Events Calendar.
- ▲ The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.
- ▲ The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
- ▲ The OC and Swiss Ski, subject to the approval of the FIS before the start of the competition and subject to the approval of the jury at the moment of the competition, reserve the right to change the schedule of the events from those published in the program, if necessary.

**Entries, Quotas and Important Forms**

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Access to the online registration system is possible through the FIS Homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com> / Member Section.

All quotas and entries are according to the FIS Rules for Continental Cup 2022/23. Only those competitors who are entered by National Associations are eligible and the number of participants is limited under current Continental Cup quotas.

### Registration/Ski pass

Team Registration will take place at the Freestyle Workspace (Via dal Farrer 2, CH-7513 Silvaplana) on Monday March 6, 2023 from 12pm to 8pm. All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration. Every athlete and team official is responsible to have the ski pass with him/her at any time during training and competition.

### Team Captain's Meeting

The first Team Captain's Meeting (online) is scheduled as follows:

### Accommodation, Food, Transportation

Accommodation for athletes and officials will be provided in various hotels in the valley Engadin. If you need help to find an accommodation, please contact Tourismus Silvaplana. We recommend to book your accommodation as soon as possible.

### Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, as follows:

- ▲ Beginning with dinner on Monday, March 6, 2023 and concluding with breakfast on Friday, March 10, 2023.
- ▲ All meals will be served at the hotel. Details will be confirmed upon check-in at the hotel

### **Lunch at Finish Area Salastrains**

We will serve lunch at the finish house Salastrains for a reasonable price. A small starter, main course and a beverage included. We kindly ask you to inform us until March 6, 2023 about the amount of athletes and coaches (per day) you would like to buy lunch for.

### **Ground Transportation**

Teams are responsible for looking after their own ground transportation. The OC does not provide shuttle services. At the bottom of the gondola Signalbahn will be free parking for teams. Access to the finish area Salastrains will only be by gondola.

### **High Altitude Training Center St. Moritz**

St. Moritz is the official Swiss Olympic «High Altitude Training Base». At 1,856 meters above sea level, the center is located at an ideal altitude for training. ### **Bibs**

All competitors must wear bibs during official training, competition, and award ceremonies.

### **Entry Fee**

Entry Fees may be charged to a maximum of Swiss Francs 80.- (CHF) per competitor per event and Swiss Francs 20.- (CHF) per competitor per official training day. The ski pass is included.

Payments only with credit card. It's also possible to pay in advance. Contact the OC to get the bank details.

## **Liability**

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, FIS Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Championships St. Moritz Engadin 2025 and Swiss Ski, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

## **Prize Money**

Prize money will be awarded at each FIS Europa Cup competition based on the total number of competitors entered into a Europa Cup event in Aerials and Moguls. The total prize money available for each event will be determined by CHF 10.-- x the total number of competitors starting in each event. Prize Money is calculated separately for each event and the total prize money is split equally between women and men. An organiser is permitted to award more prize money in excess of the formula. Prize money will be according to the following percentage of the Total Prize Money per event and taking into consideration the local tax laws: 1 st place = 50% 2 nd place = 30% 3 rd place = 20% In the case where supplemental prize money is provided the OC is allowed to determine the breakdown of percentages of prize money in excess of the minimum dictated by the rule above. Prize money is paid to the athletes at the end of each competition day. The amount of prize money will be calculated and announced at the draw before each competition at the TC meeting. The OC must assist the competitors with matters relating to taxation for prize money awarded in the country in which the competition is held.

## Accident Insurance

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The OC, Sponsors, Suppliers, Swiss Ski, FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second- and third-party claims during the event.

## Accident Protocol

In the case of accidents on course during the event, medical personnel from the OC and Ski Patrol staff will be responsible for any medical decisions or evacuation to the local hospital in co-operation with the National Sport Associations' medical staff identified on the entry form.

## Anti-Doping Control

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each gender.

## Ski Storage/Wax Cabin

The competitors, coaches and officials must store their skis and grooming equipment, as well as wax their skis in the area provided by their respective hotel. **Skis will not be allowed in your hotel room.**
