2. RULES

The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.

This competition is a Ski Cross event and is open to both men and women

This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants

The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, or by the decision of the competition jury.

3. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS qualification quotas and rules for Freestyle FIS races.

4. REGISTRATION AND MEANS OF PAYMENT

- 150 CHF or EURO per athlete (for 2 races)

According to the FIS rules:

- 1 > 3 competitors: 3 officials or accompanying persons
- 4 > 8 competitors: 5 officials or accompanying persons
- 9 & more: 6 officials or accompanying persons

CHF 30 per day for all other coaches, officials & accompanying persons

The Organising Committee, Reiteralm, the Austrian Ski Federation, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries occurred or suffered by competitors, officials or any other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.





9. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee, Reiteralm, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation will not be held responsible for accidents and, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

10. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.
