Invitation

The Relais Ski Center Lac Beauport and the Organizing Committee (OC) are pleased to invite all eligible freestyle skiers, coaches to attend the first event 2023 NorAm Cup to be held at Lac Beauport, Quebec, Canada on February 25 to 28, 2023.

The Competition is composed of two (2) Aerials events.

General Information

Date and Location

Aerials (AE) competitions and training will be on run 8C.

<u>Rules</u>

The International ski federation ("FIS") is sanctioning this Competition. The OC of the event will host the competition in accordance with the FIS Freestyle Ski Continental Cup rules.

REGISTRATION

All athletes entered in a NorAm Cup competition must hold a valid FIS License issued under the authority of their national ski association and conform to the rules in the FIS ICR Sections 203 and 204. Entry fees are 180 \$/competition

Unused spots (max 75%) will be transferred to the other gender.

<u>Bibs</u>

A bib deposit of **CAD\$ 40.00** is required. **Cash only please.** Bibs must be returned in good condition for a refund at the end of the event on February 28th. New bibs will be assign for March 3rd and 4th.Please note, we cannot guarantee that a bib deposit made in US dollars will be returned in US currency. All athletes on the course must wear bibs properly during official training and for all competitions as well as for medal ceremonies.

Format

Each athlete in individual NorAm aerial competition will usually be provided the opportunity to perform two jumps in a qualification round of competition. The athletes will be ranked based on their higher total score of the two jumps performed; the top six ranked athletes per gender will move on to the final round of competition (the "finals"). In the final round, each qualified athlete will perform a third jump; the third jump may be a repeat of a jump that was performed in the qualification round. The final results are based solely off the jumps performed in the final round.

Athletes' Biographies

Biography forms will be sent to each competitor or coaches by email. Biographies must be completed and returned to the Organizing Committee.
