Field Size

Moguls : Maximum athletes to register as per CANADA CUP GUIDELINES 2023. The table below describes in detail the distribution:

- Field Size: 85
- National Program Athletes have additional reserved spots.
- Athletes are selected on eligibility, no PSO quotas.
- Foreign Quotas: 5 per gender based on NSO approval





Format :

SINGLE:

Qualification #1: Top 8 men and top 8 women go straight to finals Qualification #2: Remaining athletes ski a second run. The next 8 men and next 8 women ranked from the best of the 2 Qualification runs also go to finals. **Finals:** 1 run final (16 men and 16 women – to be confirmed at first TCM)

DUALS:

Qualification: Single Run (ICR 4310.2)

Finals: Dual format for up to top 24 from gualifications. Duals seeded from qualification. When possible. Format will be done according to ICR rules 4310.3

Competition office – The competition office will be located in the Alphonse Desjardins building right at the bottom of the mogul run. ALL Participants must **check in** and register on-site to confirm participation in the event and to pick up competition bibs. Exceptionally for the Thursday, Registration office will be located in the gym and gym will not be available before 12pm.

Bibs: \$20.00 CAD cash bib deposit is required at registration. Bibs must be returned at the end of course or to the race office, in good condition. If a bib is lost or forgotten there will be an additional \$20 CAD deposit. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, if you need to replace your bib please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs **must** be worn properly for all on site training, for the competitions and for awards ceremonies. Please note there is only one cash machine at the resort and it can be unreliable.
