Transport

The official airport is Helsinki airport (94 km from Lahti).

The organizing committee will arrange transportation between the airports and the hotels. One free transfer per team from the official airport to the venue and one from the venue to the airport. Teams are required to send the exact arrival times, flight numbers and the number of arriving people to the organizer latest eight (8) days before arrival via the FIS Online Entry system. Price for additional transportation: 1-3 persons: 45€/ person, 4-6 persons: 190€/ transfer.

The OC provides a scheduled shuttle service to the teams between the hotels and the stadium. Time schedules are available closer to the event at the Lahti Ski Games webpage.

Parking in the service area: There will be limited space for parking. Each team will receive one (1) permit for the parking. Parking at the Cross-Country service area below the Ski Jumping service area. Drop-in possibility. The additional team parking area is located 150-200m from the service areas next to the skiing course at the "dog field". Access to the "dog field" parking area via Hämeenlinnantie 45, FI-15800 Lahti.

Reimbursement

Accommodation costs: Over-quota costs are to be paid by credit card.

Prize money

Prize money payment according to the World Cup Rules. OC will use a protected FIS database for prize money payment information. Please ensure that all your athletes' information is uploaded to the system before the competition weekend (including Tax codes).

Finnish law does not allow any prize money transfer without indicating the TINs (Tax identification number).

Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies

The Finnish Transport and Communications Agency (Traficom) regulates the use of radio frequencies in Finland. Based on submitted applications, Traficom issues radio licenses for users of radio transmitters to ensure trouble-free utilization of the radio spectrum. Applications can be submitted by filling in the form found with the link below no later than 23rd February 2023.
