Visas

To check if your nation requires a visa for entry to the United States, please visit the Department of State website. Contact cleist@orda.org to request a visa letter from the Organizing Committee.

Transportation

Each nation is responsible for making their own flight and transportation arrangements. The recommended airports are Montréal-Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport (YUL) for international arrival, or Albany International Airport (ALB) for domestic arrival.

Teams are encouraged to book a rental car at the appropriate airport for transportation to Lake Placid. The Organizing Committee will provide teams \$250 to assist with the cost of the rental vehicles.

Here is a map detailing the distance between the hotel and both the jumping and cross-country venues: Hotel Saranac – Olympic Jumping Complex – Mt. Van Hoevenberg.

Paid Training

Paid training will cost \$35/athlete/day and will be available from Monday, October 3 – Wednesday, October 5. The fee covers training at both the Olympic Jumping Complex and Mt. Van Hoevenberg. Teams will be invoiced for training on Thursday during Coach Check-in.

Lodging

There is a room block set aside at the Hotel Saranac, 100 Main St., Saranac Lake, NY 12983. Teams will receive an invoice during Coach Check-in (Wednesday 16:00-18:00) that accounts for the portion of lodging costs not covered by the Organizing Committee, per FIS Continental Cup regulations.

COVID-19 Prevention

Coach Check-in and Accreditation


Team leaders should report to the Intervales Lodge, Wednesday between 16:00 and 18:00 or Thursday between 7:30 and 8:30 for check-in, accreditation and payment of invoice. Team check-in must be completed before Official Training begins.

Ice Track Camp

The Olympic Jumping Complex is pleased to offer ice track to plastic training to all COC participants on the HS 100 and HS 128 beginning Tuesday October 11, 2022 and continuing through Saturday, October 15, 2022 at a rate of \$35.00 per day / per athlete.

On Monday, October 10, 2022 while the ice tracks are being prepared the Organizing Committee will provide access to other training facilities in the area as well as a recreational opportunities for the athletes.





Room and Board will continue to be available at the Hotel Saranac at the FIS required rate of 125 CF per person per night. Subject to availability and team request.
