Dear Masters,

Welcome to the 33rd year of the British Masters FMC, which we are delighted to be hosting in Bormio, Italy and very pleased to be working with Bormio Ski.

This year's dates are 2nd March to 5th March 2023, and we have a packed four-day program with the races being held on the iconic Stelvio and Stella Alpina pistes.

Super G training will take place on Thursday 2nd March 2023 (morning only) using the Stelvio piste starting from the top of the San Pietro jump.

Friday 3rd March 2023 – Alpine Combined race on the Stelvio piste, with the Super-G starting from the top of the San Pietro jump and the Slalom run lower down the Stelvio piste. The Super-G run will also count towards Super-G points. Same course for groups C, B and A. Prize-giving to be held at Restaurant La Rocca.

Saturday 4th March 2023 – Standard two-run slalom, same course for C, B and A, on the Stella Alpina piste. Prize-giving to be held at Restaurant La Rocca.

Sunday 5th March 2023 – Giant Slalom, one run on the Stelvio piste starting at the bottom of the San Pietro jump. Prize-giving in the finish area of the Stelvio after the race.
