## Competition venue

The city of Östersund continues to make many upgrades at the ski stadium, where more than 89 kilometers of world class biathlon and cross-country racing tracks runs at an average elevation. One of the latest upgrades consists of a new solution concerning the competition tracks for sit skiers. Östersund Ski Stadium is the Swedish National Biathlon Arena.

#### Facilities and wax cabins


The competition main offices are located at the ski stadium in the race office/secretary house. Here you can find the race office on the first floor and the info point on the ground floor.

The teams have the possibility to rent wax cabins for a cost of 500 € /cabin during the period of 16-29 January. You can also rent a set of tables and chairs for 50 €/set, same period.

The wax cabins in a size of 15 m<sup>2</sup> are located downside the shooting range, approximately 50 meters from the ski tracks. Keys to the wax cabins will be handed out and collected at the info point.

Wax cabin reservations are made on the website <u>www.winterparasport.com</u> on a first come first served basis. Teams can also rent wax cabins on site at the race office, due to availability.

## Finance & payment

#### Payment only by credit card on site

Invoices for booked accommodation packages, participation packages and wax cabins will be sent out in December 2022. Payment deadline 11 January 2023.

Invoices for booked airport shuttles will be sent out first week of January 2023.

Payment deadline 11 January 2023 OR by credit card at the airport upon arrival to Östersund before entering the buses.

Team payments will be confirmed by LOC at the welcome desks when you arrive to Östersund.

You find one welcome desk at the airport and one at the ski stadium (info point).

When your payments are verified, you will receive your accreditations.

The accreditation is a mandatory document together with the passport to be able to check-in at the hotel.

Payments are non-refundable.

Only credit cards are accepted, no invoicing or cash will be handled on site.

Late bookings of accommodation packages, airport shuttles, wax cabin rentals etc. can be made upon request at LOC info point, due to availability.

#### Credit cards and cash

Any payments made on site at the ski stadium (race office and info point) and at the hotels should be made by credit card. **No cash is accepted.** 

## Accreditations

The accreditation cards for the teams are handed out at the welcome desk upon arrival to Östersund, either at the airport or at the ski stadium (info point).

The accreditations will not be handed out if there are any outstanding payments left to be made.

Any payments last minute will be handled at the welcome desks at the airport or at Östersund Ski Stadium. Credit cards only.

All hotels will ask for passport and accreditation at check in.

The hotel check in will be closed until the teams has fulfilled their obligations to LOC.

The Biathlon arena is divided into different access zones, your access will be shown on your accreditation card. The accreditation card is your individual identification.

It is mandatory for everyone to wear their accreditation card when staying at the biathlon arena. There will be accreditation check points at the arena to ensure your safety, so please remember to always have your accreditation card with you, or you will be denied entry.

## Travel and transportation

#### Venue shuttle between Östersund Ski Stadium and official hotels

LOC will organize scheduled venue shuttles for accredited delegates on official days.

The schedule will be available at the infopoint, at the hotels and published at the website www.winterparasport.com.

The venue shuttle will operate with two kinds of vehicles, big coaches and accessible minibuses.

The coach drop off/pick up zone is located just outside the ski stadium (2 min walking distance).

The mini bus drop off/pick up zone is located just outside the team area building, an elevator ride away from the team rea.

#### Parking in Östersund

Parking at the Ski stadium is free of charge with valid parking permit.

Parking permits are available at the info point at the ski stadium or can be handed out upon arrival.

The team parking is located just in front of the ski stadium.

#### BW Hotel Ett

Free parking for hotel guests due to availability

#### Hotell Östersund

The hotel has an indoor garage for 90 SEK/24h and an outdoor garage free of charge.

Please contact the hotel directly to book and pay your parking reservations.

If you park on the street, see the section "Street parking" below.

#### Clarion Hotel Grand Östersund

The hotel has parking spaces both indoor and outdoor.

Parking is due to availability for hotel guests and you can book in advance via the link <u>Link to booking</u> – before you arrive to the hotel.

You can also book by phone at the reception +46 (0)63 55 60 00.

You can also choose parking garage or street parking at the streets around the hotel, see sections below.

Parking garage "Residensgränd 13" – 2 min walking distance from Clarion Hotel Grand Östersund Open: Monday–Friday 07.00–22.00, Saturday 09.00–22.00, Sunday 10.00–18.00 Free hight 2,05 meters.

Street parking in Östersund – goes for both Clarion Hotel Grand Östersund and Hotell Östersund Parking fee (5-15 SEK/hour depending on which area you park in)

- Monday-Friday 09.00-18.00 (daytime)
- Saturday 09.00-15:00 (daytime)
- Parking is free of charge outside those hours (follow the street signs)
- Date parking applies to the streets of Östersund with this sign. This means that parking is prohibited on the street side with even house numbers during even dates. The same applies to odd numbers on odd dates.

Scandic Östersund Syd

Free parking for hotel guests due to availability.

If the parking lot is full, there is a big parking lot just nearby, for a minor fee.

#### Car rental in Östersund – discount with Europear

LOC recommends the teams to book rental vehicles with Europear Östersund. ## Accommodation & meals

The official team hotels provide meals (dinner) and shuttle service to their accredited delegates. Please always follow given instructions regarding hand sanitizer and face masks during the competition.

Lunches will be served at the ski stadium every day between 17-29 January. Lunch includes hot dish, salad, beverage and coffee and you can choose to eat in or take away.

Dinner will be served at the hotels between 16-29 January, except 20 January when the Opening Ceremony will take place at the ski stadium in the evening.

Guests et Best Western Hotel Ett will have catered meal boxes delivered to the hotel as the restaurant is closed.

## Stella - The Star Symbol

Stella the Star Symbol - consists of 16 stars, no two stars are alike. Stella is inspired by the starry winter night sky and the idea that each athlete is a star in his or her own right, who when brought together, creates a firework of achievement.

If you look closely, each star in the symbol is unique, just like each athlete and achievement. Stella can also be used to show connectivity between seemingly different projects or activities. Stella can be used in part or as a whole, in for example background décor. It is possible to choose a particular star to mark a milestone or place on a map.
