#### **General Notes:**

- Only coaches and athletes in the start area
- Medals supplied by Snow Australia
- No gopro mounts or stickers on helmets
- Only coaches, officials and competitors in the start area
- Start intervals will be fast so racers must be clicked in and ready to go when called
- All athletes must hand bib over at finish after qualifying
- Return to the start immediately after qualifying for heats
- No hard boots, only soft boots with ratchet bindings
- Clothing, Equipment as per Fis rules for Boardercross
