RULES

This competition, for both men and women, will be held under the FIS Snowboard Freestyle Freeski World Cup Rules. All national associations affiliated to the FIS are invited to compete.

REGISTRATION / ENTRIES

Following the October Snowboard Cross World Cup postponement, teams should check their previous entries' and adjust the arrival and departure dates. Entries must be in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. These can be found on the FIS web site under SNOWBOARD & SNOWBOARD CROSS / SKI CROSS / DOCUMENTS / WORLD CUP RULES SNOWBOARD FREE STYLE FREESKI 22/23

All entries must be made through the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page within the mentioned deadlines: **FIS (fis-ski.com) : <https://profile.fis-ski.com/login>**

FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Snowboard Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations.

Provisional Entries: **23th of October 2022**

Each National Association must inform the Organizers about the expected number of team members (Names, FIS Codes and Gender, team officials), arrival and departure dates, and rooming needs (competitors, coaches, accompanying persons, and service personnel). This needs to be done using the «Competition Online Entry System».

Confirmation of Final Entries: **22th of November 2022.**

The NSA must inform the OC of its final entries (Names, FIS Code, and Gender) with their arrival and departure dates. In addition, the NSA must also notify the OC about the arrival and departure dates of the team officials.

Bear in mind that for any changes made after the final deadline, the Organizing Committee may charge the NSA concerned for any costs incurred. Teams or people who register after the deadline will not be eligible for FIS rates.



ACCOMMODATION

According to the FIS Rules Accommodation (half-board) and transportation on site will be charged at a maximum of CHF 80 per day per person (FIS Rate) to all competitors and team officials and has to be paid directly at the hotel. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves directly at the hotel.

“No Shows” will be charged to the National Associations directly at the Hotel.

COVID-19 SITUATION

To ensure the health and safety of the athletes and team personnel, the Organising Committee is working in accordance with the Regional and National Health regulations, the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines, and the World Health Organisation (WHO) information and recommendations. The OC and FIS Event Task are monitoring all developments. The corresponding arrangements are currently being put together in a separate document, which will be published and communicated by the OC later. All competitors must have medical insurance (ICR art 212) covering COVID-19 medical treatment expenses. Updated COVID-19 relevant medical procedures that may be required will be communicated if necessary.

PARTICIPATION FEE

A mandatory Participation Fee (competitors only) of a maximum of CHF 30 per official training and competition day will be charged to all entered competitors, based on the programme in the official invitation. The total amount per competitor is CHF 90 per competitor.



PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be CHF 27'500 per gender. In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to review and doublecheck the bank account information for each athlete at the FIS Member Section.

ACCREDITATION & BIBS

All officials and competitors will receive an accreditation card from the Organizing Committee providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn all the time.

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official training and competition.

LIABILITY

All athletes, officials, and other representatives of National Associations will attend at their own risk. The organizer declines any liability for damages or injuries of athletes, officials, or other people, as well as second and third-party claims during the event. Every competitor must have their medical insurance.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

ANTI DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping control may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

- ▶ Lyon-Saint Exupéry airport is 160km away.

Arriving by train?

- ▶ All trains lead to Grenoble TGV station.
- ▶ Grenoble high-speed train

station is just 70 kilometres away from Les 2 Alpes.

From Grenoble:

Take the motorway to Grenoble: exit Briançon, Vizille Exit N°8.
Then take the RD1091 towards Briançon via Le Bourg d'Oisans.
At Chambon dam, turn right and continue up the D213.
