ACCOMMODATIONS

Lodging & meals will be provided at various hotels in the Village of Bad Gastein for rate CHF 80,00. Accommodation for CHF 80,00 are for the dates of the event only. Arrival is not earlier than Sunday 9th, January. Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the rate CHF 80,00. The hotel rates are available upon request.

IMPORTANT: The dates of arrival and departure entered in the FIS Online Registration System have to be **ABSOLUTELY CORRECT!** Otherwise it's not possible for the organizing committee to book the rooms according to plan. In case of early departures or no-show, fee has to be paid anyway.

For the participants PSL departure day is 9th January 2023,
for the Parallel Slalom Team Event 10th January 2023.

The local tax will be levied at ALL LODGING ESTABLISHMENTS, on a per-guest and per-overnight-stay basis and has nothing to do with the FIS Rate of the accommodation. The amount is contingent upon the category of the establishment. Children and adolescents under 14 years of age are exempt from levy.

The local tax is payable upon departure and is listed separately on the invoice. The amount of local tax is graduated in 2023 as follows: € 3,00 per guest and night in all accommodations the same.

PARTICIPATION FEE

According to the World Cup Rules a mandatory Participation Fee of CHF 30 per competitor and competition day has to be paid to the organizing committee not later than the TC Meeting Monday 9th of January 2023.

PRIZE MONEY
