TEAM INVITATION

On behalf of the Austrian Ski Federation, the Kreischberg and the holiday Region of Murau we are pleased to invite all teams to attend the FIS Snowboard Big Air World Cup. The event will be held in accordance with the International Ski and Snowboard Federation (FIS) rules for competitions & World Cup from January 10-14, 2023.

The event starts on Tuesday, January 10, with the first TCM. Finals take place on Saturday, January 14, 2023. There is no reserve day in case of bad weather.

COVID-19 SITUATION

At the moment, there are no restrictions concerning the event.

Nevertheless, we recommend the use of a face mask. Everyone is self-responsible to bring a face mask. Persons with disease symptoms should please absent themselves from the event.

Should there be changes regarding the general Covid-19 regulations, we will communicate those changes as soon as possible.

REGISTRATION

Entries will only be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules for slopestyle events. Entries are open now and must be submitted to the OC using the FIS online registration system within the mentioned deadlines and please keep in mind the 60 day deadline (14 of November) as maximum field sizes will be applied if needed as by W.C rules. Please read carefully the W.C. quota sheets and procedures.

Please make sure that all athletes have a valid FIS license.

The World Cup rules are available on the FIS website.

Provisional entry deadline <u>November 14, 2022</u>. Final entry deadline <u>December 31, 2022</u>.

ACCOMMODATION

Team accommodation, halfboard at CHF 80,- per day per person in doubleroom according to the FIS World Cup rules will be offered for the dates of the official program. Additional officials or accompanying persons and staff will be charged with CHF 110,- per day per person. According to World Cup rule 2.2.1.3.

Please note that accommodation at the FIS rate is available for the dates of the program only.

PARKING & TRAFFIC

The area around the bottom station of the Kreischberg Bahnen bottom station provides enough parking possibilities for all of you.

ACCREDITATION

Registration and accreditation will be held at the Kreischberghalle on January 10 and 11 2022. Please see the official event schedule for registration times. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the registration office for check-in before proceeding to their accommodations or the competition venue. If you are planning to bring a media team with you or know of someone wishing to cover the event, please note that they must be accredited by the Kreischberg World Cup media office. This applies whether they are editorial media or filming for promotional purposes.

Media accreditation requests prior to the arrival are appreciated.

ENTRY FEES

An administration fee will be charged for each World Cup competitor. All fees will be collected upon check-in at the registration office. We accept debit and credit cards as well as cash. The administrative fee is CHF 200,- (as per FIS rules) per competitor.

LIFT TICKETS

Lift tickets will be provided to all competitors and team officials for official training and competition days and will be distributed at the first team captains' meeting.

The number of free lift tickets given out to team officials will be relative to the team's size (as per FIS World Cup rules).

BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all scheduled official trainings, competition and at the award ceremony. Training and competition bibs will also be allocated at the team captains meetings.

A cash only deposit of € 50,- per bib will be required in cash at the first team captains' meeting.

ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All competitors must have their own medical insurance.

The organizing committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and members of National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk.

The organizing committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing and staging of the event.

FIRST TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETING

The first team captains' meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 10, 10:30am CET for Snowboard and on Tuesday, January 5, 19:00pm CET at the Kreischberghalle.

TRAINING

The official training days are scheduled for January 11 and 12.

Additional training will take place before each heat during competition and quali times on January 13 and 14.

SANCTIONING

Athletes must have a valid FIS license to compete.

AWARD CEREMONY

Medal ceremonies will take place on the mountain immediately after the competitions' final. Podium placing athletes are obliged to attend these ceremonies and should be available for media interviews and athlete signings immediately after the awards.

PRIZE MONEY

The total prize purse for Big Air is **CHF 55,000** per FIS rules and payments. The prize money breakdown is in accordance with the FIS rules and all money transfers will be made electronically within 7 business days after the event.

In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to **review and doublecheck** the **bank account information** for each athlete at the FIS Member Section.
