1. Description, dates and venue

The Winter Jam arena is built in the landing of the great Ski Jumping hill of Falun Lugnet. There have been previous events in the arena such as the Battle, Clash of Nations and now Winter Jam is back. Previous Winter Jam was held in the Olympic Arena of Stockholm Stadion from 2005-2011. In Stockholm the jump was build out of scaffolding, now we will build it entirely out of snow. The model of the jump that has been done is with a 10m wide kicker, a 14 m high landing with 22m wide knuckle. This jump will ensure a great and safe competition pushing the sport forward.

The event will be in combination with a snowmobile Big Air invitational as well as music acts and parties. The sports arena is within less than 10 min walk from the hotel, Scandic Hotel Lugnet. See sketch.



2. Registration/entries

Entries for Winter Jam shall be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas & rules for World Cup, & must be processed by the National Sports Association through the FIS Online Registration & Entry System www.fis-ski.com (Member Section).

Provisional deadline for entries, including competitors & officials: Freeski Sept 25th 2022 23:00 CET, 23:00 CET, Snowboard Sept 25th 2022 23:00 CET.

Limited competitor fields sizes will be in place as by World cup quota calculations & all entries not done prior to the provisional entry date will not be considered. The numbers of competitors are 30 women and 50 men as it will be considered a city event and not a resort event. The quotas can be downloaded on the FIS website:

3. How to get there

Teams are responsible for their own transportation to & from Falun. It is easy to get to from anywhere in Europe, by public transport, car or plane.

By plane - Fly to Stockholm — Arlanda Airport then connecting transport to Falun via one of the options below:

By bus - The LOC will arrange a bus transport from Arlanda to Falun at a cost of 70CHF per person, one way. Booking through the FIS system.

By public transportation - To travel by train there is a train station under the airport, book your tickets here. Transportation is less than 3h. We suggest that you book your train ticket as early as possible.

By car - Falun is a 2,5h drive from Arlanda. For rentals at the airport <u>click here</u>.

VISA - Travelers from outside EU may need a visa to enter Sweden for more info: Visiting Sweden - Sweden Abroad

On site - All facilities is in a walking distance in the arena. From the hotel to the event arena its less than 10 min walk. Just outside the main entrance it's the rider's office. All team captains' meetings will be held in the hotel. Waxing facilities close to the arena. Lift takes 3,5 min from top to bottom, make sure you are in time before your start. There is a small house on top of the arena where there will be drinks and snacks and as well a warm place to hang out before your start. The start of the inrun is below the take off for the ski jumping arena and holds a great view over the city and the spectators. The venue itself allows for a unique experience as you drop in under the lights for the night finals. The ambience is great and with elevated spectator stands the crowd gets really close to where the action is.



4. Accommodation - conditions

Accommodation according to FIS WC rules 2.2.1. All prices are available from Nov 22 – 26, 2022 (Freeski)
Nov 22 – 27, 2022 (Snowboard)

Double room CHF 80 per person/night, incl. breakfast & dinner (for teams)

Double room CHF 110 per person/night, incl. breakfast & dinner (for additional officials & service personnel)

Note: these conditions are applicable for bookings that are made by October 15 2022 at the latest. Reservations after this date will not be offered, so please make sure to settle your accommodation needs prior to this date, thank you!

Meals

Half board accommodation will be provided starting with dinner Tuesday, Nov 22 and will include breakfast on Saturday, Nov 26 (Freeski) or Sunday, Nov 27 (Snowboard). Half board accommodation includes breakfast & dinner at the hotel. Information about lunch options, most likely at the Big Air venue, will follow (at own expense).

Please do not book through booking agents or hotel platforms as they do not grant the above mentioned discounted rates. Payment is due at the hotel. Please coordinate early arrivals or late departures yourself directly with your hotel, thank you.

5. Onsite registration & accreditation

Team registrations & fee payments will take place at Scandic hotel Lugnet at arrival day the 22 of November, rest of the days at the RIDERS & ACCREDITATION OFFICE at the event venue. The fee is CHF 150 per rider. Please note that only credit cards or other electronical payments are accepted, preferably Mastercard, Visa or EC Maestro (no American Express). There is no cash handling at the accreditation office.

Your accreditiation gives you access to all competition sites/areas, as well as to the Riders Lounge & to an onsite waxing area, including storage space for your gear. Your accreditation also gives you access to the concert area, provided there are no Covid or other restrictions implement by the FIS for World Cup events.





6. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs appropriately during all scheduled trainings, competition & at the awards ceremony. Bibs will be distributed at the 1st Team Captains Meeting, held the night prior to the 1st training. Competitors keep their bibs throughout the event.

7. Official notice board

The Official Notice Board will be located at the RIDERS & ACCREDITATION OFFICE.

8. Team captain meetings

Daily Team Captain Meetings are planned at Scandic Hotel Lugnet. If Covid restrictions need to be implemented again, there will be an online setup for attending the TC meeting virtually.

9. Prize money and award ceremonies

A total purse of CHF 110'000 will be awarded for the Winter Jam 2022. The prize purse is divided into CHF 55'000 for each sport, Freeski & Snowboard. The prize money will be awarded and divided between the top 10 competiters of each gender per event.

Winners will receive their prize money via bank transfer. NSAs are responsible for entering the personal bank information for each athlete using the Athlete Registration module in the FIS Member Section. Incomplete, wrong or no bank details will result in non-payment. Prize money payments shall deduct income source taxes, as required by Swedish law.

Award ceremonies are held immediately after the Finals on the main concert stage, located right next to the Big Air contest finish area, or in the finish area of the Big Air setup.

All podiums winners (1-2-3) women & men are required to stay available immediately after the last run of the Finals. Wearing your own contest bib for the award ceremony is mandatory.

After a short break, the Award Ceremonies are followed by The Snowmobile Big Air Invitational contest.





10. Liability and insurances

All athletes, officials & members of National Associations who attend & participate in the event shall do so at their own risk, competitors must have their own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees & volunteers, the FIS & Swiss Ski decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment & second & third party claims in connection with the event.

All athletes & team members shall be required to sign a Liability Disclaimer as well as a Media Disclaimer before receiving access to the event, this is processed at the RIDERS & ACCREDITATION OFFICE. PDF files of these disclaimers shall be posted on the event's microsite in due time.

11. Anti-doping and medical plan

Anti-doping control may be conducted for this event.

At all times during trainings & contests there is a dedicated medical crew onsite, including an onsite stationed ambulance. The Falun county hospital is located 1,5km from the arena.

12. Note on Covid-19

There are currently no Covid rules & guidelines from the Swedish health authorities or from the FIS for World Cup events, & we shall plan accordingly. Nevertheless, we are prepared to implement safety measures to any extent on short notice, should there be new rules & regulations required between now & the event. The organizer has multiple experiences is staging events under Covid measures.
