SPEED NATION SUNSHINE VILLAGE

Banff Sunshine Village is the first Snowboard Cross stop of the Speed Nation SBX Tour.

Speed Nation SBX Sunshine Village brings together the best SBX athletes in North America to compete in a Snowboard Cross event in two days.

THE RESORT

At Banff Sunshine Village you'll feel a world away, without the hassle of complicated directions. Banff Sunshine Village is conveniently located just 135 km (80 miles) west of the Calgary International Airport and only 8 km (5 miles) west of Banff on the Trans-Canada Highway (#1). Eligibility

Competitors must meet the following age limit in order to compete:

SBX - 15 years+ by December 31, 2022

Competitors must also hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial or Territorial Snowboard Association Membership before registering through your Provincial or Territorial Association.

Athlete Lift Tickets: \$95 per day

YOUTH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM

The Youth Performance Program (YPP) is a Canada Snowboard Program that aims to provide more opportunities to all stages of athletes and coaches. This camp will be split into two parts: Performance, and Development. The Performance camp is for any athletes currently competing in events at the NorAm level or above, where we are aiming to create more training opportunities. The Development camp is for athletes at any Long-Term Development stage looking to develop new skills in a discipline they are not familiar with. National Team Coach Alumni, Jake Holden, will be on staff to mentor coaches. This camp will provide opportunities for skill development, nation-wide athlete assessment, and inter-team training within the snowboard cross community.
