SPEED NATION - Ontario

Speed Nation Ontario is third of the Air Nation SBX Tour and will bring together the best Freestyle athletes in North American to compete in two Snowboard Cross competitions.

THE RESORT

Horseshoe Resort is home to 61 acres of ski and snowboard terrain with 308ft of elevation from the base of the slopes, all located a brief one-hour drive from Toronto. Explore 28 runs including Outlaw Terrain Park, which can be accessed quickly off the Copeland Express high-speed six-person chair, seen as you enter the resort. With excellent progression features from beginner to expert, all levels can have a blast at the park. Riders can explore all runs with convenient RFID access to six chair lifts, including expanded night skiing across 82% of the hill.

Eligibility

Competitors must meet the following age limit to compete:

NorAm / FIS Events - 15 years + old by December 31. 2022

Competitors must hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial or Territorial Snowboard Association Membership before registering through your Provincial or Territorial Association.
