During the competition, you must wear a pearl. It is also desirable to use the back and knees protectors.

PARTICIPATION FEE AND LIFT TICKET

Participation fee is 10 eur per discipline or 20 eur for bouth big air and slopestyle.

Lift tickets can be bought at the venue. Price for 2 days lift ticket: 40 euro this is a special price only for competitors and coaches.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Slopestyle competition will have qualification and final competition. Competitors will have chance to do 2 runs of which 1 best will count for final result.

Big air competition will have qualification and final competition. Competitors will have chance to do 3 jumps of which 2 will sum for final result. It has to be two different tricks.
