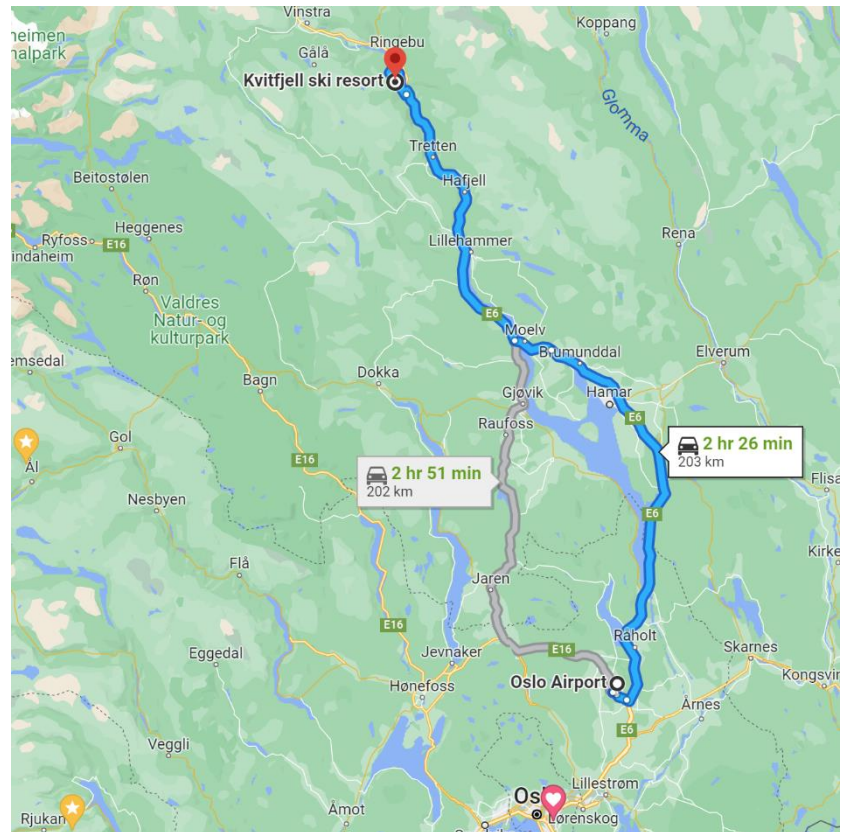
How to get to Kvitfjell?
