Training times

- 12th and 13th of December: the CC course will be open for free training according to the times set in the event schedule.
- 14th, 15th and 16th of December: there will be official training in the CC course at the times set in the event schedule.

Prices and rules:

- The LOC will cover accommodation costs according to the FIS World Cup rules.
- The price for accommodation outside of the quota or for additional nights is CHF 125 per person in a double room (minimum number of persons occurs). The price for additional single rooms is CHF 160.
- In case of extra single rooms inside the quota the cost difference between single and double room must be paid.
- For nations with starting quota 4 or more the LOC will cover one single room.
- FIS deadline, Preliminary entries: 20/10/2023
- FIS deadline, entries: 07/12/2023

Cancellation rules and fees:

- Cancellation fee between 8 days and until the end of the events: 100% cancellation fee.
- For cancellations of more than what is stated in the rules above the LOC will charge a 100% cancellation fee.

Accreditation

- The accreditation cards will be handed out at the LOC office/info desk at Scandic Lerkendal Hotel. Please note that the accreditation will be approved according to the registrations in the FIS Entry. Those who have the FIS season accreditation can use this instead of the local accreditation.

Official transport and shuttle

- As part of the sustainability program for the FIS WSC Trondheim 2025, the LOC has organized a mandatory plan for transport and accommodation for the teams/athletes.

From Östersund

- Transport from Östersund to Trondheim will be coordinated. The transport schedule and cost will be published on both LOC Östersund and LOC Trondheim's websites.

Transport from/to the Airport before and after the event

- Official Airport: Værnes (TRD)
- Transport from/to the airport (TRD) will be organized free of charge under the following conditions: Only one free of charge transfer per team from the official airport to the hotel and one from the hotel to the airport; Only for the staff people included in the staff quota; The arrival and departure times must be communicated to the LOC at the latest 10 days before the first competition day. Please fill in your request through the FIS online registration system.
- Bus transport will be organised from Scandic Lerkendal Hotel to Trondheim Airport (TRD) on Sunday 17th December.
- Price for additional transport between the Scandic Lerkendal hotel and Trondheim Airport: up to 15 persons = EUR 250, 16-50 persons = EUR 350

Between the hotel and the venue in Granåsen

- Frequent bus shuttle transport between Scandic Lerkendal hotel and the venue in Granåsen will be organised on training days and competition days starting from Monday, December 11th. Ending on Sunday, December 17th.
- From Monday until Wednesday, the schedule will be fixed with a time frame for training before lunch and a time frame after lunch.
- From Thursday 12th the schedule will be fixed according to official training times and competitions times.
- Transport schedule will be published at the website and in the info desk at Scandic Lerkendal Hotel.

Parking in Granåsen arena and at the hotel

- Due to limited parking spaces in Granåsen, only accredited vehicles will be allowed to enter the arena. The roads to the arena are one-way and traffic will be limited. In addition, we expect the nations to follow the LOC sustainability goal of zero emissions. Each nation accredits maximum two vehicles.
- The accreditation card for cars will be handed out at the LOC office/info desk at Scandic Lerkendal Hotel.

Reimbursement

- Expenses sheets must be sent to finance@trondheim2025.no. Payments will be done by bank transfer.

Prize money

- Prize Money will be paid by bank transfer to the athletes after event. The prize money is regulated by the FIS Rules for World Cup. Receipts will be provided to the athlete electronically and a copy transmitted to FIS.
- Remember to upload bank info using the FIS Athlete Registration module in the FIS member section. Responsible for prize money: hedda.hoel@skiforbundet.no

Income tax information for prize money

- Income tax of European citizens is 15%
- Income tax of non-European citizens is 15% (exception occur for USA citizens; income tax is 0% unless the total prize money exceeds USD 10 000).
- Tax will be deducted by the LOC according to the Norwegian Foreign Artist Taxation Act, and taxes will be paid by the OC according to the regular tax legislation in Norway.

Waxing facilities

- Wax cabins and parking space for the waxing trucks are located in the team area, above the stadium.
- Wax cabins are available from 10/12/2023 at 14:00.

- The key to the wax cabins will be handed over from the service office located in the team area. The deposit is EUR 100/team. Key return and deposit return to the service office at the waxing area.

Team catering



- Costs for lunch service at the venue is EUR 10 per person per day for over quota or if you haven't ordered and paid full board via the Organizing Committee.
- All teams will have full board at the hotel. From Thursday to Sunday, we will have food in the main stadium building. If you want to eat there you need to register for it via entry and get the vouchers through sign-up form. Without a voucher you will not get any food.
- To avoid food waste, please let the hotel know who is eating lunch in the hotel or on site.
