

ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

Access to the online registration system is possible through the FIS Homepage http://www.fis-ski.com / Member Section.

All quotas and entries are according to the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Rules 2023/24. Only those competitors who are entered by National Associations are eligible and the number of participants is limited under current World Cup quotas.

Provisional Entries:

Monday 23. October 2023

Each National Association must inform the Organizers about the expected total number of team members (Names, FIS Codes and Gender, team officials) arrival and departure dates. This needs to be done using the "Competition Online Entry System".

Final Entries:

Wednesday 22. November 2023

No later than 10 days before the competition day the NSA must inform the OC of its final entries (Names, FIS Code and Gender) with their arrival and departure dates. Teams or persons who register after the deadline will not be eligible for FIS rates.





ACCOMODATION

Accommodation, with FIS rate of 20 CHF with no meals, for athletes and officials during the competition days is provided in Ruka Ski-Inn units, located in the immediate closeness of the ski area.

All accommodation reservations must be done directly to Ruka Ski Resort.

Each Team will pay all their accommodation expenses upon arrival, directly to Ruka Ski Resort.


RACE OFFICE, ACCREDITATION AND SKI PASSES

Race Office is located in Ruka Congress Center, bottom floor.

Race office opens on the arrival day at 10:00. Team Captains will receive accreditations and ski passes from the race office (ski pass starts on arrival day already).

BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition, and award ceremonies.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be transferred to the athlete's account electronically (NO need to visit the race office for that).

Each NSA is responsible in filling the athletes bank account information to the FIS database, using the Athlete Registration module in the FIS Member Section. Note that a withholding tax will be retained as per Finnish Income Tax Law. The organizing Committee might need a copy of the athlete's passport due to Finnish Law, the athletes will be contacted by the address they have listed in the FIS Prize money system.
