Introduction

Levi Ski Club, Levi Ski Resort and Ski Sport Finland invite national freestyle teams to two FIS Moguls European Cup events in single moguls (MO) on Thursday 15th and Friday 16th February 2024. The events act as replacement events for Jyväskylä, Finland.

The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition Rules (ICR) and Rules for Continental Cup of the International Ski Federation (FIS).

The course will be ready for teams to train from Tuesday 13th February.
