FIS SKI CROSS WORLD CUP

Val Thorens – France

December 7th - 8th 2023

The French Ski Federation and the Organizing Committee of the FIS SKI CROSS WORLD CUP in Val Thorens are pleased to invite all Nations to attend this event from December 7th to 8th, 2023.

For your information, the reserve day is on the Saturday 9th december.

1 / Program

You will find enclosed the provisional program of the event according to the FIS calendar. The OC reserves the right to modify this schedule, depending on the snow conditions or / and the decision of the competition jury.

Please note that the TCM will take place in the Meeting room of the "Maison de Val Thorens" on the 1st floor under the Club des Sports reception. The first one will be on Sunday the 3th at 20.00pm.

2 / Arrival

The appointment for the welcome, information and accommodation will be at the Sport's Club Office at the « Maison de Val Thorens » on Sunday 3th December 2023 between 03.00 and 06.00 pm.

Outside these hours, for all different questions regarding the organisation, please ask directly at the Club des Sports reception : Opening hours : 09.00 - 12.00 am & 03.00 - 05.00 pm

Each competitor and officiel will receive a 6 days SX stadium skipass and a wristban. This wristband must be worn all the time and showed if required.









3 / Accommodation

Teams will be accommodated in several hotels or residences *** and more on a half-board basis from Sunday evening the 3th of December to Saturday 9th December (6 nights). The OC takes over lunches of December 7/8 directly on the SXWC' site as usual. Other lunches are on teams' charge.

Each team will pay the total of the accommodation expenses at their arrival to the OC and a fully refundable breakage deposit will be required directly by the hotel or residence (major credit card only).

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, mini bar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes directly at the hotel.

The FIS' rate is CHF60 / day / pax.

The official single room FIS' quota is 2 single rooms per team.

Allocation of additional single rooms per team must be provided at a rate of CHF 100 according to the following table:

3 or 4 officials = 1 additional single room

5 or 6 officials = 2 additional single rooms

7 or more officials = 3 additional single rooms

If more single rooms are requested, this will be subject to availability and local market rates will apply.

Please, fill in your accommodation needs on the FIS Online Entry System (Team size) with a provisional completed rooming list with any requirements about rooms & place sharing before **October 26th**, **2023**.

4/ Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

The preliminary entries date is October 26th 2023 and the final entries of your competition team (competitors, officials, and other staff) with your arrival and departure dates (Names, FIS code for the participants and Gender) must be submitted to the organising committee no later than **November 25th 2023**.

For any changes notified after this deadline, the organizing committee may invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Ski Association concerned. Teams or persons who register late have no right to reservation at the FIS rate.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded: <u>https://www.fis-ski.com/en/inside-fis/document-library/freestyle-freeski-documents</u>

Competitors entered into FIS Ski Cross World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Ski Cross points in one of the valid FIS points list.

5/ Bibs

All competitors must wear their bibs during the official training, competition and awards ceremony after the competition.









6/ Prize money & Prize money taxes

Please note that the prize money will be transferred to the athletes' account. NSAs are responsible for entering the personal bank information for each athlete using the Athlete Registration module in the FIS Member Section.

A withholding French tax (15%) will be retained on the prize money.
