Registration/Entries

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

All updated entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page: http://www.fis-ski.com/ "Member Section". FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations.

Deadlines for Team Entries:

Preliminary Entries (women/men): November 1st, 2023

Final Entries: December 1st, 2023

Accommodation

According to the FIS Rules the rates are CHF 60.00/night per team member (athletes and team officials) for accommodation, including half-board and has to be paid directly at the hotel. Accommodation at the FIS rate will be provided for the period of December 10 - 13, 2023; 3 nights. Two single rooms per country for the team officials will be provided. Allocation of additional single rooms per team is porivded at a rate of CHF 100.00 according to the amount of officials (3 o 4 officials = 1 additional, etc. / rule 4.3.6.1). Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves directly at the hotel.

"No Shows" will be charged to the National Associations directly at the Hotel.

<u>Important information</u>: To accommodate all athletes, coaches and officials in a correct way, we do need your updated Preliminary Team Entries <u>as soon as possible</u>, November 1st, 2023, the latest.

After the above mentioned Deadline for Team Entries the FIS rate for hotel accommodation can't be guaranteed anymore.

By car: Highway from Zurich to Chur and then about 45 minutes up a winding mountain road (30

kilometres). Car Rentals at the Airport possible.

The competitors must wear bibs during the official trainings, competition and award ceremonies.

Prize Money

In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to review and doublecheck the bank account information for each athlete at the FIS Member Section.
