EVENT DESCRIPTION

The NZ Freestyle National Champs awards New Zealand Champion age division titles in Slopestyle. Ski and Snowboard-cross, and this year "The Nationals" will also include a Rail Jam. Unfortunately, due to the lack of snow the Halfpipe has had to be cancelled for 2023.

The Nationals starts off on Thursday the 28th of September with the Cardrona NZ Freestyle Nationals ANC Slopestyle, followed by the Big Air on Saturday 30th September. Event podiums will be awarded, and FIS registered athletes are eligible for FIS results and points towards the 2023 FIS ANC series.

The age division Freestyle Nationals kicks off with our welcome on at 6pm on Sunday the 1st of October at Apres. The first day of scheduled competition is Monday the 2nd of October.

Freeride Big Mountain disciplines are no longer included in the NZ Freestyle Nationals as the New Zealand Junior Freeride Tour (NZJFT) provide the competitive pathway and NZ Championship titles for Freeride snowboard and Big Mountain skiing disciplines.

NOTE: FIS and Open age competitors compete in Big Bucks on Thursday/Friday and the Big Air on Saturday There is no Open Stag Lane to Antlers Alley division.

Competitors who chose to compete in the Open FIS ANC disciplines are also able to compete in the age divisions disciplines. Overall age division (U8 – U18) NZ titles are calculated by combined rankings from Slopestyle, Rail Jam and Ski / Snowboard-cross only. Competitors must remain in the same age division for all three disciplines.

Competitors who change age divisions during the event forfeit their chance at winning the Overall titles for their age division.

This excludes the open division for the FIS ANC events. An athlete is welcome to compete in the Open Division for FIS ANC events only and then compete in their age division for the Freestyle Nationals Slopestyle, Cross and Rail Jam held on 2-4 October.

There will not be Overall NZ National Title's awarded for the Open Division in 2023, but open athletes will win podiums.

EVENT REGISTRATION

Entries close 5pm Tuesday 26th September 2023. Late entries and "On the day" (OTD) entries will be subject to a \$15 late fee. In the event of postponements or cancellations entries will be fully refunded.

Competitors will be able to collect their bibs and lift passes from Sunday 1st October at Slope side guest services on the mountain providing they have pre-registered for the event. On the day entries may incur a fee and must be registered before 8:15am. Entries after this time will not be accepted. Competitor bibs will be assigned to athletes for the whole week. Any bibs that are not returned will incur a \$40 replacement fee. Competitor Bibs MUST be collected in advance to avoid errors with the daily competition start lists.

EVENT FORMATS & RULES

Two judged runs best score counts (straight finals). Slopestyle: SX/SBX: 1 run time trial qualifier to seed riders for ¼, Semis or Final rounds. (No race suits!) Rail Jam: Jam format within each age division. 1st to 3rd place receive podium awards and prizes.

AWARDS

There will be a daily awards presentation held in the Cardrona Courtyard at the conclusion of each event, NZ titles will be awarded to 1st - 3rd in each age division & discipline. Overall NZ Titles will be announced at the After-party scheduled for 6:30pm, Friday 6th October at Apres.

WEATHER POSTPONEMENTS

There is one weather days scheduled for the FIS ANC and two weather days scheduled for the Age Divisions and NZ Championship titles. If an event is postponed, it will move to the postponement day and the dates for the remaining disciplines will remain the same. In the event of multiple postponements an athletes/coaches meeting will be scheduled after the awards to discuss any schedule changes.
