Special Procedures

Foreign Inscriptions we be received on a first come basis. A maximum entry of 10 per gender will be accepted for the start. If more than 10 in any gender are received, then those athletes will be ranked by most current FIS points as of the November 22nd, 2023 cut off. National teams will then be notified by November 24th of the official Foreign event entry. If there are drops at that time, the list will be adjusted to reflect the best 10 per gender.
