Field Size:

In accordance with NAC 10.3- Quotas:

Each nation is provided an equal number of quota spots for men and women; each nation is expected to provide equal opportunity per gender to fill spots. The quotas for the NorAm Cup Tour for MO/DM events are as follows:

Moguls and Dual Moguls CAN 50 - Maximum of 30 per Gender USA 50 - Maximum of 30 per Gender Foreign Nations 30 Maximum Field Size 130 23/24 Season Minimum FIS Points = 0







24/25 Season Minimum FIS Points = 5

International Athletes must have an active FIS license.

- All participants must check in and register on-site at the main desk to confirm participation in the event and to pick up competition bibs.

<u>Bibs:</u> Bibs must be returned at the end of course or to the race office, **in good condition**. Any bibs NOT RETURNED in good condition will result in that athlete being charged a \$45 replacement fee. It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring, if you need to replace your bib please ensure the on-site registration staff updates your entry information. Bibs **must** be worn properly for all on site training, for the competitions and for awards ceremonies.

Athlete Bio:

To be completed upon check in at the registration office. Announcers will use this information when introducing each competitor.
